- An Act relating to peace officers of the department of public

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 80.9A, subsection 6, Code 2018, is
 amended by adding the following new paragraph:

3 <u>NEW PARAGRAPH</u>. *h*. When a city does not employ permanent 4 peace officers or has not established law enforcement duties in 5 the city pursuant to a chapter 28E agreement.

7 8 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

9 This bill relates to peace officers of the department of 10 public safety exercising the general powers of a peace officer 11 in cities without a permanent police force.

12 The bill permits peace officers of the department of public 13 safety to exercise the general powers of a peace officer in 14 cities that do not employ permanent peace officers or when the 15 city has not established law enforcement duties pursuant to 16 a Code chapter 28E agreement. Currently, a peace officer of 17 the department of public safety shall not exercise the general 18 powers of a peace officer in cities except as provided in Code 19 section 80.9A(6).
