A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the dispensing of cash from a device
- 2 located at a licensed pari-mutuel wagering or gambling game
- 3 facility.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 99D.9, subsection 6, paragraph b, Code
2 2018, is amended to read as follows:

3 b. A licensee shall not permit a financial institution,
4 vendor, or other person to dispense ~~cash~~ or credit through an
5 electronic or mechanical device including but not limited to a
6 satellite terminal as defined in [section 527.2](#), that is located
7 in the wagering area.

8 Sec. 2. Section 99D.9, subsection 6, paragraph c, Code 2018,
9 is amended by striking the paragraph.

10 Sec. 3. Section 99F.7, subsection 10, paragraph b, Code
11 2018, is amended to read as follows:

12 b. A licensee shall not permit a financial institution,
13 vendor, or other person to dispense ~~cash~~ or credit through an
14 electronic or mechanical device including but not limited to
15 a satellite terminal, as defined in [section 527.2](#), that is
16 located on the gaming floor.

17 Sec. 4. Section 99F.7, subsection 10, paragraph c, Code
18 2018, is amended by striking the paragraph.

19 EXPLANATION

20 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
21 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

22 This bill eliminates the prohibition against allowing a
23 person to utilize an electronic or mechanical device to receive
24 cash that is located in the wagering area or on the gaming
25 floor of a licensed pari-mutuel wagering or gambling game
26 facility.

27 The bill also eliminates the requirement that a licensed
28 pari-mutuel wagering or gambling game facility, when
29 technologically feasible, shall ensure that a person may
30 voluntarily bar themselves from access to receive cash or
31 credit on the wagering area or on the gaming floor of the
32 licensed facility.
