## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the amounts paid to a receiving school
- 2 district for a pupil participating in open enrollment and
- 3 including applicability provisions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 282.18, subsection 7, Code 2018, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 7. a. A pupil participating in open enrollment shall be
- 4 counted, for state school foundation aid purposes, in the
- 5 pupil's district of residence. A pupil's residence, for
- 6 purposes of this section, means a residence under section
- 7 282.1. The board of directors of the district of residence
- 8 shall pay to the receiving district an amount equal to the sum
- 9 of the following:
- 10 (1) Regular program state cost per pupil for the previous 11 school year plus either.
- 12 (2) Either the teacher leadership supplement state cost per
- 13 pupil for the previous fiscal year as provided in section 257.9
- 14 or the teacher leadership supplement foundation aid for the
- 15 previous fiscal year as provided in section 284.13, subsection
- 16 1, paragraph "d", if both the district of residence and the
- 17 receiving district are receiving such supplements, plus any.
- 18 (3) The teacher salary supplement state cost per pupil for
- 19 the previous fiscal year.
- 20 (4) The professional development supplement state cost per
- 21 pupil for the previous fiscal year.
- 22 (5) The early intervention supplement state cost per pupil
- 23 for the previous fiscal year.
- 24 (6) The area education agency teacher salary supplement
- 25 state cost per pupil for the previous fiscal year.
- 26 (7) The area education agency professional development
- 27 supplement state cost per pupil for the previous fiscal year.
- 28 (8) The state media services cost per pupil for the previous
- 29 fiscal year.
- 30 (9) The special education support services state cost per
- 31 pupil for the previous fiscal year.
- 32 (10) The state educational services cost per pupil for the
- 33 previous fiscal year.
- 34 (11) Any moneys received for the pupil as a result of the
- 35 non-English speaking weighting under section 280.4, subsection

- 1 3, for the previous school year multiplied by the regular
- 2 program state cost per pupil for the previous fiscal year.
- 3 b. If the pupil participating in open enrollment is also
- 4 an eligible pupil under section 261E.6, the receiving district
- 5 shall, in addition to the amount paid under paragraph "a", pay
- 6 the tuition reimbursement amount to an eligible postsecondary
- 7 institution as provided in section 261E.7.
- 8 Sec. 2. APPLICABILITY. This Act applies school budget years
- 9 beginning on or after July 1, 2019.
- 10 EXPLANATION
- 11 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 12 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- Current Code section 282.18(7) provides that a pupil
- 14 participating in open enrollment shall be counted, for state
- 15 school foundation aid purposes, in the pupil's district of
- 16 residence. The school district of residence then is required
- 17 to pay to the receiving district the sum of the state cost per
- 18 pupil for the previous school year plus either the teacher
- 19 leadership supplement state cost per pupil for the previous
- 20 fiscal year or the teacher leadership supplement foundation aid
- 21 for the previous fiscal year if both the district of residence
- 22 and the receiving district are receiving such supplements,
- 23 plus any moneys received for the pupil as a result of the
- 24 non-English speaking weighting and any eligible postsecondary
- 25 tuition reimbursement amounts under Code section 261E.7, if
- 26 applicable.
- 27 This bill adds the following amounts from the previous
- 28 fiscal year to the total sum required to be paid by the
- 29 school district of residence to the receiving district: (1)
- 30 the teacher salary supplement state cost per pupil; (2) the
- 31 professional development supplement state cost per pupil; (3)
- 32 the early intervention supplement state cost per pupil; (4) the
- 33 area education agency teacher salary supplement state cost per
- 34 pupil; (5) the area education agency professional development
- 35 supplement state cost per pupil; (6) the state media services

- 1 cost per pupil; (7) the special education support services
- 2 state cost per pupil; and (8) the state educational services
- 3 cost per pupil.
- 4 By operation of law, the changes in the bill also apply
- 5 to the amount required to be paid by a resident district to
- 6 a charter school or innovation zone consortium under Code
- 7 chapter 256F when the pupil enrolls in such a school outside
- 8 the pupil's district of residence.
- 9 The bill applies to school budget years beginning on or after
- 10 July 1, 2019.
