- 6 building codes regarding accessibility and compliance
- 7 requirements pursuant to any state or federal law regarding
- 8 accessibility, including the federal Americans With
- 9 Disabilities Act of 1990, as amended. The seminars shall be
- 10 open to the public and the commission shall allow interested
- 11 persons to participate in person or by telephone. The
- 12 commission shall provide the opportunity for interested persons
- 13 to ask questions.
