A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the use of triclosan in certain products,
2 providing civil penalties, and including effective date
3 provisions.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 135.191 Triclosan prohibition —
2 civil penalty.

3 1. A person shall not offer for retail sale in this state
4 any cleaning product that contains triclosan and is intended
5 to be used by the consumer for sanitizing or hand or body
6 cleansing.

7 2. The prohibition in subsection 1 shall not apply to
8 individual products for which specific United States food and
9 drug administration approval for consumer use has been secured.

10 3. A person who violates this section is subject to a civil
11 penalty of one thousand dollars for each violation.

12 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect January 1,
13 2019.

14 EXPLANATION

15 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
16 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

17 This bill, beginning January 1, 2019, prohibits the retail
18 sale of any cleaning product that contains triclosan and is
19 intended to be used by the consumer for sanitizing or hand or
20 body cleansing. The prohibition shall not apply to individual
21 products for which specific United States food and drug
22 administration approval for consumer use has been secured. The
23 bill provides that a person who violates the bill is subject to
24 a civil penalty of \$1,000 for each violation.
