            ISSUANCE AND DISPLAY OF ONE REGISTRATION PLATE
               Section 8A.362, subsection 7, Code 2017, is amended
 8 to read as follows:
          The director shall require that a sign be placed on
10 each state-owned motor vehicle in a conspicuous place which
11 indicates its ownership by the state. This requirement
12 shall not apply to motor vehicles requested to be exempt by
13 the director or by the commissioner of public safety. All
14 state-owned motor vehicles shall display a registration
15 plates plate bearing the word "official" except motor vehicles
16 requested to be furnished with an ordinary plates plate by the
17 director or by the commissioner of public safety pursuant to
18 section 321.19. The director shall keep an accurate record of
19 the registration plates used on all state-owned motor vehicles.
20 This subsection shall not apply to an assigned vehicle rented
21 or leased pursuant to section 8A.367.

      Sec. 3. Section 321.18, subsection 7, Code 2017, is amended
23 to read as follows:
      7. Any school bus in this state used exclusively for
25 the transportation of pupils to and from school or a school
26 function or for the purposes provided in section 285.1,
27 subsection 1, and section 285.10, subsection 9, or used
28 exclusively for the transportation of children enrolled in a
29 federal head start program. Upon application the department
30 shall, without charge, issue a registration certificate and
31 registration plates plate. The plates plate shall be attached
32 to the front and rear of each bus exempt from registration
33 under this subsection.

- 7 (2) Persons enforcing chapter 124 and other laws relating to

- 9 (3) Persons in the department of justice, the alcoholic

- ll investigators of the Iowa department of public health, the

- 3 (a) Upon removing the license plates plate and registration

- 5 destruction, as appropriate, and forward the registration
- 6 receipt and evidence of the violation, as determined by the
- 7 department, to the county treasurer of the county in which the
- 8 motor vehicle is registered.

- 14 vehicle. The peace officer shall deliver the plates plate
- 15 for destruction, as appropriate, and forward the registration
- 16 receipt and evidence of the violation, as determined by the
- 17 department, to the county treasurer of the county in which the
- 18 motor vehicle is registered.
- 19 Sec. 8. Section 321.20B, subsection 4, paragraph b,
- 20 subparagraph (1), subparagraph divisions (a) and (b), Code
- 21 2017, are amended to read as follows:
- 22 (a) If the person was cited pursuant to paragraph "a",
- 23 subparagraph (3), the owner or driver shall provide a copy of
- 24 the receipt to the county treasurer of the county in which the
- 25 motor vehicle is registered and the owner shall be assessed a
- 26 fifteen dollar administrative fee by the county treasurer who
- 27 shall issue a new license plates plate and registration to the
- 28 person after payment of the fee.
- 29 (b) If the person was cited pursuant to paragraph "a",
- 30 subparagraph (4), the owner or driver, after the owner
- 31 provides proof of financial liability coverage to the clerk
- 32 of court, may claim the motor vehicle after such person pays
- 33 any applicable fine and the costs of towing and storage for
- 34 the motor vehicle, and the owner or driver provides a copy
- 35 of the receipt and the owner pays to the county treasurer of

- 1 the county in which the motor vehicle is registered a fifteen 2 dollar administrative fee, and the county treasurer shall issue 3 a new license plates plate and registration to the person. Section 321.20B, subsection 4, paragraph b, 5 subparagraph (2), subparagraph divisions (a) and (b), Code 6 2017, are amended to read as follows: Sign an admission of violation on the citation and 8 remit to the clerk of court a scheduled fine as provided in 9 section 805.8A, subsection 14, paragraph "f", for a violation of 10 subsection 1. Upon payment of the fine to the clerk of court of 11 the county where the citation was issued, payment of a fifteen 12 dollar administrative fee to the county treasurer of the 13 county in which the motor vehicle is registered, and providing 14 proof of payment of any applicable fine and proof of financial 15 liability coverages to the county treasurer of the county in 16 which the motor vehicle is registered, the treasurer shall 17 issue a new license plates plate and registration to the owner. 18 (b) Request an appearance before the court on the matter. 19 If the matter goes before the court, and the owner or driver 20 is found guilty of a violation of subsection 1, the court 21 may impose a fine as provided in section 805.8A, subsection 22 14, paragraph "f", for a violation of subsection 1, or the 23 court may order the person to perform unpaid community 24 service instead of the fine. Upon the payment of the fine 25 or the entry of the order for unpaid community service, the 26 person shall provide proof of payment or entry of such order 27 and the county treasurer of the county in which the motor 28 vehicle is registered shall issue a new license plates plate 29 and registration to the owner upon the owner providing proof 30 of financial liability coverage and paying a fifteen dollar 31 administrative fee to the county treasurer.
- Sec. 10. Section 321.22, subsection 1, Code 2017, is amended
- 33 to read as follows:
- 34 1. An urban transit company or system having a franchise
- 35 to operate in any city and any regional transit system may

- 1 make application to the department, upon forms furnished by
- 2 the department, for a certificate containing a distinguishing
- 3 number and for one or more pairs of registration plates to be
- 4 attached to the front and rear of buses owned or operated by
- 5 the transit company or system.
- 6 Sec. 11. Section 321.23, subsection 3, Code 2017, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 3. In the event an applicant for registration of a foreign
- 9 vehicle for which a certificate of title has been issued is
- 10 able to furnish evidence of being the registered owner of the
- 11 vehicle to the county treasurer of the owner's residence,
- 12 although unable to surrender such certificate of title,
- 13 the county treasurer may issue a registration receipt and
- 14 plates plate upon receipt of the required annual registration
- 15 fee and the fee for new registration but shall not issue a
- 16 certificate of title thereto for the vehicle. Upon surrender
- 17 of the certificate of title from the foreign state, the county
- 18 treasurer shall issue a certificate of title to the owner, of
- 19 the vehicle or other person entitled thereto, of such vehicle
- 20 to the certificate of title as provided in this chapter. The
- 21 owner of a vehicle registered under this subsection shall not
- 22 be required to obtain a certificate of title in this state and
- 23 may transfer ownership of the vehicle to a motor vehicle dealer
- 24 licensed under chapter 322 if, at the time of the transfer,
- 25 the certificate of title is held by a secured party and the
- 26 dealer has forwarded to the secured party the sum necessary to
- 27 discharge the security interest pursuant to section 321.48,
- 28 subsection 1.
- Sec. 12. Section 321.25, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2017,
- 30 is amended to read as follows:
- 31 A vehicle may be operated upon the highways of this state
- 32 without a registration plates plate for a period of forty-five
- 33 days after the date of delivery of the vehicle to the purchaser
- 34 from a dealer if a card bearing the words "registration applied
- 35 for "is attached on the rear of the vehicle. The card shall

- 1 have plainly stamped or stenciled the registration number of 2 the dealer from whom the vehicle was purchased and the date 3 of delivery of the vehicle. In addition, a dealer licensed 4 to sell new motor vehicles may attach the card to a new motor 5 vehicle delivered by the dealer to the purchaser even if the 6 vehicle was purchased from an out-of-state dealer and the card 7 shall bear the registration number of the dealer that delivered 8 the vehicle. A dealer shall not issue a card to a person known 9 to the dealer to be in possession of a registration plates 10 plate which may be attached to the vehicle. A dealer shall 11 not issue a card unless an application for registration and 12 certificate of title has been made by the purchaser and a 13 receipt issued to the purchaser of the vehicle showing the fee 14 paid by the person making the application. Dealers' records 15 shall indicate the agency to which the fee is sent and the date 16 the fee is sent. The dealer shall forward the application by 17 the purchaser to the county treasurer or state office within 18 thirty calendar days from the date of delivery of the vehicle. 19 However, if the vehicle is subject to a security interest 20 and has been offered for sale pursuant to section 321.48, 21 subsection 1, the dealer shall forward the application by the 22 purchaser to the county treasurer or state office within thirty 23 calendar days from the date of the delivery of the vehicle to 24 the purchaser. 25 Sec. 13. Section 321.26, subsection 2, Code 2017, is amended
- 26 to read as follows:
- 27 The county treasurer may adjust the renewal or expiration 28 date of vehicles when deemed necessary to equalize the number 29 of vehicles registered in each twelve-month period or for the 30 administrative efficiency of the county treasurer's office. 31 The adjustment shall be accomplished by delivery of a written 32 notice to the vehicle owner of the adjustment and allowance of 33 a credit for the remaining months of the unused portion of the 34 annual registration fee, rounded to the nearest whole dollar, 35 which amount shall be deducted from the annual registration

1 fee due at the time of registration. Upon receipt of the 2 notification the owner shall, within thirty days, surrender the 3 registration card and registration plates plate to the county 4 treasurer of the county where the vehicle is registered, except 5 that the registration plates plate shall not be surrendered 6 if a validation stickers sticker or other emblems are emblem 7 is used to designate the month and year of expiration of 8 registration. Upon payment of the annual registration fee, 9 less the credit allowed for the remaining months of the 10 unused portion of the annual registration fee, the county 11 treasurer shall issue a new registration card and registration 12 plates plate, validation stickers sticker, or emblems emblem 13 which indicate indicates the month and year of expiration of 14 registration. 15 Sec. 14. Section 321.34, subsections 1, 2, and 3, Code 2017, 16 are amended to read as follows: 17 1. Plates Plate issued. The county treasurer upon receiving 18 application, accompanied by proper fee, for registration of a 19 vehicle shall issue to the owner one registration plate for 20 a motorcycle, motorized bicycle, autocycle, truck tractor, 21 trailer, or semitrailer and two registration plates for every 22 other motor vehicle. The registration plates plate, including 23 any special registration plates plate, shall be assigned 24 to the owner of a vehicle. When the owner of a registered 25 vehicle transfers or assigns ownership of the vehicle to 26 another person, the owner shall remove the registration plates 27 plate from the vehicle. The owner shall forward the plates 28 plate to the county treasurer where the vehicle is registered 29 or the owner may have the plates plate assigned to another 30 vehicle within thirty days after transfer, upon payment of the 31 fees required by law. The owner shall immediately affix the 32 registration plates plate retained by the owner to another 33 vehicle owned or acquired by the owner, providing the owner

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34 complies with section 321.46. The department shall adopt rules 35 providing for the assignment of a registration plates plate to

1 the transferee of a vehicle for which a credit is allowed under 2 section 321.46, subsection 6.

- Validation stickers.
- 4 a. In lieu of issuing a new registration plates plate
- 5 each registration year for a vehicle renewing registration,
- 6 the department may reassign the registration plates plate
- 7 previously issued to the vehicle and may adopt and prescribe
- 8 an annual validation sticker indicating payment of annual
- 9 registration fees. The department shall issue one validation
- 10 sticker for each set of registration plates plate. The
- 11 sticker shall specify the month and year of expiration of the
- 12 registration plates plate. The sticker shall be displayed
- 13 only on the rear registration plate, except that the sticker
- 14 shall be displayed on the front registration plate of a truck
- 15 tractor.
- 16 b. The state department of transportation shall adopt rules
- 17 to provide for the placement of the motor vehicle registration
- 18 validation sticker.
- 19 3. Radio operators plates. The owner of an automobile,
- 20 motorcycle, trailer, or motor truck who holds an amateur radio
- 21 license issued by the federal communications commission may,
- 22 upon written application to the county treasurer accompanied
- 23 by a fee of five dollars, order a special registration plates
- 24 plate bearing the call letters authorized the radio station
- 25 covered by the person's amateur radio license. When received
- 26 by the county treasurer, such special registration plates
- 27 plate shall be issued to the applicant in exchange for the
- 28 registration plates plate previously issued to the person. Not
- 29 more than one set of special registration plates plate may be
- 30 issued to an applicant. Said fee shall be in addition to and
- 31 not in lieu of the fee for a regular registration plates plate.
- 32 Special A special registration plates plate must be surrendered
- 33 upon expiration of the owner's amateur radio license and the
- 34 owner shall thereupon be entitled to the owner's regular
- 35 registration plates plate. The county treasurer shall validate

- 1 special plates in the same manner as regular registration
- 2 plates, upon payment of five dollars in addition to the regular
- 3 annual registration fee.
- 4 Sec. 15. Section 321.34, subsection 5, paragraph a, Code
- 5 2017, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 a. Upon application and the payment of a fee of twenty-five
- 7 dollars, the director may issue to the owner of a motor
- 8 vehicle registered in this state or a trailer or travel trailer
- 9 registered in this state, a personalized registration plates
- 10 plate marked with up to seven initials, letters, or combination
- 11 of numerals and letters requested by the owner. However,
- 12 personalized registration plates for autocycles, motorcycles,
- 13 and motorized bicycles shall be marked with no more than six
- 14 initials, letters, or combinations of numerals and letters.
- 15 Upon receipt of the personalized registration plates plate,
- 16 the applicant shall surrender the regular registration plates
- 17 plate to the county treasurer. The fee for issuance of the
- 18 personalized registration plates plate shall be in addition to
- 19 the regular annual registration fee.
- Sec. 16. Section 321.34, subsection 6, Code 2017, is amended
- 21 to read as follows:
- 22 6. Sample vehicle registration plates. Vehicle A vehicle
- 23 registration plates plate displaying the general design of
- 24 a regular registration plates plate, with the word "sample"
- 25 displayed on the plate, may be furnished to any person upon
- 26 payment of a fee of three dollars, except that such plates may
- 27 be furnished to governmental agencies without cost. Sample A
- 28 sample registration plates plate shall not be attached to a
- 29 vehicle moved on the highways of this state.
- 30 Sec. 17. Section 321.34, subsection 7, paragraphs a and e,
- 31 Code 2017, are amended to read as follows:
- 32 a. Upon application and payment of the proper fees, the
- 33 director may issue to the owner of a motor vehicle subject
- 34 to registration under section 321.109, subsection 1, motor
- 35 truck, motor home, multipurpose vehicle, trailer over two

- 1 thousand pounds, or travel trailer registered in this state,  $\underline{a}$
- 2 collegiate registration plates plate created pursuant to this
- 3 subsection. Upon receipt of the collegiate registration plates
- 4 plate, the applicant shall surrender the regular registration
- 5 plates plate to the county treasurer.
- 6 e. A collegiate registration plate shall not be issued if
- 7 its combination of alphanumeric characters are identical to
- 8 those contained on a current personalized registration plate
- 9 issued under subsection 5. However, the owner of a motor
- 10 vehicle who has a personalized registration plate issued for
- 11 the motor vehicle may, after proper application and payment
- 12 of fees, be issued a collegiate registration plate containing
- 13 the same alphanumeric characters as those on the personalized
- 14 plate. Upon receipt of the collegiate registration plates
- 15 plate, the owner shall surrender the personalized registration
- 16 plates plate to the county treasurer.
- 17 Sec. 18. Section 321.34, subsection 7A, paragraphs b and c,
- 18 Code 2017, are amended to read as follows:
- 19 b. Upon application and payment of the proper fees, the
- 20 director may issue to the owner of a motor vehicle subject
- 21 to registration under section 321.109, subsection 1, motor
- 22 truck, motor home, multipurpose vehicle, trailer over two
- 23 thousand pounds, or travel trailer registered in this state,
- 24 a collegiate registration plates plate created pursuant to
- 25 this subsection. The fee for the issuance of a collegiate
- 26 registration plates plate is twenty-five dollars, which fee
- 27 is in addition to the regular annual registration fee for the
- 28 vehicle. An applicant may obtain a personalized collegiate
- 29 registration plate upon payment of the additional fee for a
- 30 personalized plate as provided in subsection 5 in addition to
- 31 the collegiate plate fee and the regular registration fee. The
- 32 county treasurer shall validate collegiate registration plates
- 33 issued under this subsection in the same manner as regular
- 34 registration plates, upon payment of five dollars in addition
- 35 to the regular annual registration fee. Upon receipt of the

- 1 collegiate registration plates plate, the applicant shall
- 2 surrender the regular registration plates plate to the county
- 3 treasurer.
- 4 c. A personalized collegiate registration plate shall
- 5 not be issued if its combination of alphanumeric characters
- 6 are identical to those contained on a current personalized
- 7 registration plate issued under subsection 5. However, the
- 8 owner of a motor vehicle who has a personalized registration
- 9 plate issued for the motor vehicle may, after proper
- 10 application and payment of fees, be issued a collegiate
- ll registration plate containing the same alphanumeric characters
- 12 as those on the personalized plate. Upon receipt of the
- 13 collegiate registration plates plate, the owner shall surrender
- 14 the personalized registration plates plate to the county
- 15 treasurer.
- 16 Sec. 19. Section 321.34, subsections 8, 8A, and 9, Code
- 17 2017, are amended to read as follows:
- 18 8. Medal of honor plates.
- 19 a. The owner of a motor vehicle subject to registration
- 20 under section 321.109, subsection 1, autocycle, motorcycle,
- 21 trailer, or motor truck who has been awarded the medal of
- 22 honor may, upon written application to the department, order a
- 23 special registration plates plate which shall be red, white,
- 24 and blue in color and shall bear an emblem of the medal of
- 25 honor and an identifying number. Each applicant applying for
- 26 a special registration plates plate under this subsection may
- 27 order only one set of registration plates plate under this
- 28 subsection. The application is subject to approval by the
- 29 department and the special registration plates plate shall
- 30 be issued at no charge to the applicant in exchange for the
- 31 registration plates plate previously issued to the person.
- 32 A person who is issued a special plates plate under this
- 33 subsection is exempt from payment of any annual registration
- 34 fee for the motor vehicle bearing the special plates plate.
- 35 The department shall validate the special plates in the same

- 1 manner as regular registration plates are validated under this
- 2 section. The department shall not issue special registration
- 3 plates until service organizations in the state have furnished
- 4 the department either the special dies or the cost of the
- 5 special dies necessary for the manufacture of the special
- 6 registration plate.
- 7 b. The surviving spouse of a person who was issued a special
- 8 plates plate under this subsection may continue to use the
- 9 special plates plate subject to registration of the special
- 10 plates plate in the surviving spouse's name. If the surviving
- ll spouse remarries, the surviving spouse shall return the special
- 12 plates plate to the department and the department shall issue a
- 13 regular registration plates plate to the surviving spouse.
- 14 8A. Ex-prisoner of war special plates.
- 15 a. The owner of a motor vehicle subject to registration
- 16 under section 321.109, subsection 1, autocycle, motorcycle,
- 17 trailer, or motor truck who was a prisoner of war during a
- 18 time of military conflict may, upon written application to
- 19 the department, order only one set of special registration
- 20 plates plate with an ex-prisoner of war processed emblem. The
- 21 emblem shall be designed by the department in cooperation
- 22 with the adjutant general and shall signify that the owner
- 23 was a prisoner of war as described in this subsection. The
- 24 application is subject to approval by the department, in
- 25 consultation with the adjutant general. The special plates
- 26 plate shall be issued at no charge and are is subject to
- 27 an annual registration fee of fifteen dollars. The county
- 28 treasurer shall validate the special plates in the same
- 29 manner as regular registration plates are validated under this
- 30 section.
- 31 b. The surviving spouse of a person who was issued a special
- 32 plates plate under this subsection may continue to use or apply
- 33 for and use the special plates plate subject to registration
- 34 of the special plates plate in the surviving spouse's name and
- 35 upon payment of the annual registration fee. If the surviving

- 1 spouse remarries, the surviving spouse shall return the special
- 2 plates plate to the department and the department shall issue a
- 3 regular registration plates plate to the surviving spouse.
- 4 9. Leased vehicles. Registration plates A registration
- 5 plate under this section, including a disabled veteran plates
- 6 plate specified in section 321.105, may be issued to the lessee
- 7 of a motor vehicle if the lessee provides evidence of a lease
- 8 for a period of more than sixty days and if the lessee complies
- 9 with the requirements, under this section, for issuance of the
- 10 specific registration plates plate.
- 11 Sec. 20. Section 321.34, subsection 10, paragraphs a, b, and
- 12 d, Code 2017, are amended to read as follows:
- 13 a. An owner referred to in subsection 12 who is a current
- 14 or retired member of a paid or volunteer fire department may,
- 15 upon written application to the department, order a special
- 16 registration plates plate, designed by the department in
- 17 cooperation with representatives designated by the Iowa fire
- 18 fighters' associations, which signify that the applicant
- 19 is a current or retired member of a paid or volunteer fire
- 20 department.
- 21 b. The application shall be approved by the department in
- 22 consultation with representatives designated by the Iowa fire
- 23 fighters' associations, and the special registration plates
- 24 plate shall be issued to the applicant in exchange for the
- 25 registration plates plate previously issued to the person. An
- 26 applicant who is the owner of a business-trade truck or special
- 27 truck shall not be issued a special fire fighter registration
- 28 plates plate for more than one vehicle. The fee for the
- 29 special plates plate is twenty-five dollars which shall be
- 30 paid in addition to the regular annual registration fee. The
- 31 department shall validate the special plates in the same manner
- 32 as regular registration plates are validated under this section
- 33 at the regular annual registration fee.
- 34 d. For purposes of this subsection, a person is considered
- 35 to be retired if the person is recognized by the chief of the

- 1 fire department where the individual served, and on record,
- 2 as officially retired from the fire department. Special A
- 3 special registration plates plate with a fire fighter emblem
- 4 shall be surrendered, as provided in subsection 12, in exchange
- 5 for a regular registration plates plate upon termination of
- 6 the motor vehicle owner's membership in the paid or volunteer
- 7 fire department, unless the person is a retired member in good
- 8 standing.
- 9 Sec. 21. Section 321.34, subsection 10A, paragraph a, Code
- 10 2017, is amended to read as follows:
- 11 a. The owner of a motor vehicle referred to in subsection
- 12 12 who is a current member of a paid or volunteer emergency
- 13 medical services agency may, upon written application to
- 14 the department, order a special registration plates plate,
- 15 designed by the department in cooperation with representatives
- 16 designated by the Iowa emergency medical services association,
- 17 which plates signify signifies that the applicant is a current
- 18 member of a paid or volunteer emergency medical services
- 19 agency. The application shall be approved by the department,
- 20 in consultation with representatives designated by the Iowa
- 21 emergency medical services association, and the special
