A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the provision of integrated health home
2 services under Medicaid managed care, and including
3 effective date provisions.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. PROVISION OF INTEGRATED HEALTH HOME SERVICES
2 UNDER MEDICAID MANAGED CARE. The department of human services
3 shall amend Medicaid managed care contracts and adopt rules
4 pursuant to chapter 17A to require all of the following:

5 1. That integrated health home services be provided
6 in accordance with the state plan amendment, IA-16-013,
7 including the requirement that comprehensive care coordination
8 services be provided by care coordinators who are part of the
9 integrated health home's team of health care professionals
10 to meet provider standards and deliver health home services
11 to qualified members. Comprehensive care coordination for
12 Medicaid members receiving integrated health home services
13 shall not be provided in a manner other than through the use of
14 integrated health home provider types as specified in the state
15 plan amendment, and shall not be provided by the managed care
16 organization through internal resources or other contracted
17 providers.

18 2. That if a Medicaid member is receiving integrated health
19 home services, and based on the member's array of services
20 would potentially have more than one case manager or care
21 coordinator, the member shall be provided the opportunity to
22 select the member's own case manager or care coordinator.
23 Additionally, such Medicaid member shall be allowed to change
24 the integrated health home provider from whom the member
25 receives integrated health home services.

26 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate
27 importance, takes effect upon enactment.

28 EXPLANATION

29 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
30 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

31 This bill requires the department of human services (DHS) to
32 amend Medicaid managed care contracts to require the following:

33 1. That integrated health home services be provided
34 in accordance with the state plan amendment, IA-16-013,
35 including the requirement that comprehensive care coordination

1 services be provided by care coordinators who are part of the
2 integrated health home's team of health care professionals
3 to meet provider standards and deliver health home services
4 to qualified members. Comprehensive care coordination shall
5 not be provided in a manner other than through the use of the
6 integrated health home provider types as specified in the state
7 plan amendment, and shall not be provided by the managed care
8 organization through internal resources or other contracted
9 providers.

10 2. That if a Medicaid member is receiving integrated health
11 home services, and based on the member's array of services
12 would potentially have more than one case manager or care
13 coordinator, the member shall be given the opportunity to
14 select the member's own case manager or care coordinator.
15 Additionally, such Medicaid member shall be allowed to change
16 the integrated health home provider from whom the member
17 receives integrated health home services.

18 The bill takes effect upon enactment.
