SENATE FILE 212 BY BREITBACH

## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act concerning payment of insurance premium costs by
- 2 members and full-time employees of the general assembly and
- 3 including effective date and applicability provisions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. Section 2.40, subsection 1, paragraph a,
- 2 subparagraphs (1) and (2), Code 2017, are amended to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 (1) The member shall be eligible for all state group
- 5 insurance plans on the basis of enrollment rules established
- 6 for the largest number of full-time state employees of the
- 7 executive branch excluded from collective bargaining as
- 8 provided in chapter 20.
- 9 (2) The member shall pay that portion of the total premium
- 10 for the plan selected on the same basis as a paid by the largest
- 11 number of full-time state employees of the executive
- 12 branch excluded from collective bargaining as provided in
- 13 chapter 20.
- 14 Sec. 2. Section 2.40, subsection 1, paragraph a,
- 15 subparagraph (4), Code 2017, is amended by striking the
- 16 subparagraph.
- 17 Sec. 3. Section 2.40, Code 2017, is amended by adding the
- 18 following new subsection:
- 19 NEW SUBSECTION. 3. A full-time employee of the general
- 20 assembly may elect to become a member of a state group
- 21 insurance plan for employees of the state established under
- 22 chapter 509A subject to the following conditions:
- 23 a. The full-time employee shall be eligible for all
- 24 state group insurance plans on the basis of enrollment rules
- 25 established for the largest number of full-time state employees
- 26 of the executive branch excluded from collective bargaining as
- 27 provided in chapter 20 and shall have the same rights to change
- 28 programs or coverage as are afforded such state employees.
- 29 b. The full-time employee shall pay that portion of the
- 30 total premium for the plan selected on the same basis as
- 31 paid by the largest number of full-time state employees of
- 32 the executive branch excluded from collective bargaining as
- 33 provided in chapter 20.
- 34 c. A member of a state group insurance plan pursuant to this
- 35 subsection shall have the same rights upon final termination

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- 1 of employment as are afforded the largest number of full-time
- 2 state employees excluded from collective bargaining as provided
- 3 in chapter 20.
- 4 Sec. 4. EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT. This Act, being deemed of
- 5 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 6 Sec. 5. APPLICABILITY. This Act applies to a member of
- 7 the general assembly or a full-time employee of the general
- 8 assembly electing to become or to continue as a member of a
- 9 state group insurance plan established anew under chapter 509A
- 10 that becomes effective on or after the effective date of this
- 11 Act.
- 12 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 15 This bill concerns membership in state insurance plans by
- 16 members and full-time employees of the general assembly.
- 17 The bill provides that members of the general assembly who
- 18 become a member of the state group insurance plan for employees
- 19 of the state established under Code chapter 509A shall be
- 20 eligible under the same enrollment rules established for the
- 21 largest number of noncontract full-time state employees of
- 22 the executive branch and shall pay that portion of the total
- 23 premium for the plan selected on the same basis as paid by the
- 24 largest number of noncontract full-time state employees of
- 25 the executive branch. The bill strikes language relating to
- 26 premium rates in Code section 2.40(1)(a)(4).
- 27 The bill also provides that a full-time employee of the
- 28 general assembly may elect to become a member of a state group
- 29 insurance plan for employees of the state established under
- 30 Code chapter 509A under the same enrollment rules established
- 31 for the largest number of noncontract full-time state employees
- 32 of the executive branch. The bill further provides that if
- 33 the full-time employee becomes a member of a state group
- 34 insurance plan, the employee shall pay that portion of the
- 35 total premium for the plan selected on the same basis as paid

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- 1 by the largest number of noncontract full-time state employees
- 2 of the executive branch.
- 3 The bill takes effect upon enactment and is made applicable
- 4 to a member of the general assembly or full-time employee of
- 5 the general assembly electing to become or to continue as a
- 6 member of a state group insurance plan that becomes effective
- 7 on or after the effective date of the bill.
