**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to the responsibility of a child support  
2 obligor to report termination of employment or other income.  
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 252D.17, subsection 1, paragraph i, Code  
2 2018, is amended to read as follows:

3 *i.* (1) The payor shall promptly notify the court or the  
4 child support recovery unit when the obligor's employment or  
5 other income terminates, and provide the obligor's last known  
6 address and the name and address of the obligor's new employer,  
7 if known.

8 (2) The obligor shall notify the court or the child support  
9 recovery unit, within five business days following termination  
10 of the obligor's employment or other income, and provide the  
11 obligor's last known address and the name and address of the  
12 obligor's new employer, if known.

13 EXPLANATION

14 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with  
15 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

16 This bill requires that, with reference to income  
17 withholding of support payments for the payment of a child  
18 support obligation which is applicable to all child support  
19 orders, a child support obligor shall notify the court or the  
20 child support recovery unit within five business days following  
21 termination of the obligor's employment or other income, and  
22 provide the obligor's last known address and the name and  
23 address of the obligor's new employer, if known.
