(SUCCESSOR TO SSB 3027)

A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the expiration date of a license issued by
2 the board of educational examiners.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 272.7, subsection 1, Code 2018, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 1. A license issued under board authority is valid for the
4 period of time for which it is issued, unless the license is
5 suspended or revoked. ~~A license issued by the board is valid~~
6 ~~until the last day of the practitioner's birth month in the~~
7 ~~year in which the license expires.~~ No permanent licenses shall
8 be issued. A person employed as a practitioner shall hold a
9 valid license with an endorsement for the type of service for
10 which the person is employed. This section does not limit
11 the duties or powers of a school board to select or discharge
12 practitioners or to terminate practitioners' contracts. A
13 professional development program, except for a program offered
14 by a practitioner preparation institution or area education
15 agency and approved by the state board of education, must
16 possess a valid license for the types of programs offered.

EXPLANATION

18 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
19 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

20 This bill eliminates a provision that requires the
21 expiration date of a license issued by the board of educational
22 examiners to be the last day of the license holder's birth
23 month.
