## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act expanding the Iowa learning online initiative to
- 2 include students receiving independent private instruction,
- 3 competent private instruction, or private instruction and
- 4 providing for related fees.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. Section 256.42, subsections 1, 5, and 8, Code 2 2018, are amended to read as follows:
- An Iowa learning online initiative is established
- 4 within the department to partner with school districts and
- 5 accredited nonpublic schools to provide distance education
- 6 to high school students statewide. The initiative may also
- 7 provide distance education to a student receiving independent
- 8 private instruction as defined in section 299A.1, subsection
- 9 1, paragraph "b", competent private instruction under section
- 10 299A.2, or private instruction by a nonlicensed person under
- 11 section 299A.3. The department shall utilize a variety of
- 12 content repositories, including those maintained by the area
- 13 education agencies and the public broadcasting division, in
- 14 administering the initiative.
- 15 5. Under the initiative, students a student must be
- 16 enrolled in a participating school district or accredited
- 17 nonpublic school, which or be receiving private instruction
- 18 under chapter 299A as described in subsection 1. For a student
- 19 enrolled in a participating school district or accredited
- 20 nonpublic school, the school district or school is responsible
- 21 for recording grades received for initiative coursework in a
- 22 student's permanent record, awarding high school credit for
- 23 initiative coursework, and issuing high school diplomas to
- 24 students a student enrolled in the district or school who
- 25 participate participates and complete completes coursework
- 26 under the initiative. Each participating school shall identify
- 27 a site coordinator to serve as a student advocate and as a
- 28 liaison between the initiative staff and teachers and the
- 29 school district or accredited nonpublic school. The individual
- 30 providing instruction to a student under chapter 299A as
- 31 described in subsection 1 shall receive the student's score for
- 32 completed initiative coursework.
- 33 8. The department shall establish fees payable by school
- 34 districts, and accredited nonpublic schools participating
- 35 in, and individuals providing instruction to students under

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- 1 chapter 299A as described in subsection 1, for coursework 2 offered under the initiative. Fees collected pursuant to 3 this subsection are appropriated to the department to be 4 used only for the purpose of administering this section and 5 shall be established so as not to exceed the budgeted cost of 6 administering this section to the extent not covered by the 7 moneys appropriated in subsection 9. Providing professional 8 development necessary to prepare teachers to participate in the 9 initiative shall be considered a cost of administering this 10 section. Notwithstanding section 8.33, fees collected by the 11 department that remain unencumbered or unobligated at the close 12 of the fiscal year shall not revert but shall remain available 13 for expenditure for the purpose of expanding coursework offered 14 under the initiative in subsequent fiscal years. 15 Sec. 2. Section 256.42, subsection 9, Code 2018, is amended 16 by striking the subsection.
- 17 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- This bill expands the Iowa learning online initiative to allow a student receiving independent private instruction, competent private instruction by a licensed practitioner, or private instruction by a nonlicensed person to participate and complete coursework under the initiative if the parent, guardian, or legal custodian providing such instruction pays to the initiative the fee established by the department of education for such coursework.
- Under the bill, the individuals providing the instruction
- 29 will receive the student's scores for completed coursework.
- 30 Currently, only school districts and accredited nonpublic
- 31 schools may partner with the initiative to provide distance
- 32 education to high school students.
- Obsolete provisions relating to the appropriation of moneys
- 34 in prior fiscal years are stricken.
