A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to kidnapping in the second degree, and
- providing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

S.F. 2230

- 1 Section 1. Section 710.3, Code 2018, is amended to read as 2 follows:
- 3 710.3 Kidnapping in the second degree.
- 4 1. Kidnapping where the purpose is to hold the victim
- 5 for ransom, or where the kidnapper is armed with a dangerous
- 6 weapon, or where the victim is under eighteen years of age
- 7 other than a kidnapping by a parent or legal guardian whose
- 8 sole purpose of the kidnapping is to assume custody of a victim
- 9 under eighteen years of age, is kidnapping in the second
- 10 degree. Kidnapping in the second degree is a class "B" felony.
- 11 2. For purposes of determining whether the person should
- 12 register as a sex offender pursuant to the provisions of
- 13 chapter 692A, the fact finder shall make a determination as
- 14 provided in section 692A.126.
- 15 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 18 This bill relates to kidnapping in the second degree. The
- 19 criminal offense of kidnapping is defined in Code section
- 20 710.1.
- 21 Under the bill, a person commits kidnapping in the second
- 22 degree when the victim is under 18 years of age, except that
- 23 it is not kidnapping in the second degree when the kidnapping
- 24 is by a parent or legal guardian whose sole purpose of the
- 25 kidnapping is to assume custody of the victim under 18 years
- 26 of age. Currently, a person commits kidnapping in the second
- 27 degree when a person kidnaps another person and holds that
- 28 person for ransom or when the kidnapper is armed with a
- 29 dangerous weapon.
- 30 A person who commits kidnapping in the second degree commits
- 31 a class "B" forcible felony. A person who commits a forcible
- 32 felony is ineligible to receive a deferred judgment or sentence
- 33 or suspended sentence under Code section 907.3.
- A class "B" felony is punishable by confinement for no more
- 35 than 25 years. A person who commits kidnapping in the second

- 1 degree accumulates reduced earned time under Code section
- 2 903A.2 and must serve a minimum sentence of at least 70 percent
- 3 of the sentence prior to being eligible for parole.
- A person who commits kidnapping in the second degree under
- 5 the bill must also register as a tier III sex offender under
- 6 Code chapter 692A if a determination is made that the offense
- 7 was sexually motivated.
