1 Section 1. DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES - MANDATORY 2 REPORTER TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION WORKGROUP. The department 3 of human services, in cooperation with the departments of 4 education and public health, shall facilitate a study by a 5 workgroup of stakeholders to make recommendations relating 6 to mandatory child abuse and mandatory dependent adult 7 abuse reporter training and certification requirements. 8 workgroup shall develop interdepartmental strategies for 9 improving mandatory child abuse and mandatory dependent 10 adult abuse reporter training and certification requirements. 11 The workgroup shall consist of representatives from the 12 departments of human services, education, and public health, 13 and other experts the department of human services deems 14 necessary. The workgroup shall submit a report on the study 15 with recommendations, including but not limited to strategies 16 developed and other proposed improvements, to the governor and 17 the general assembly on or before December 14, 2018. 18 **EXPLANATION** 19 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly. 20 21 This bill requires the department of human services to 22 facilitate a study by a workgroup, in cooperation with the 23 departments of education and public health, related to 24 mandatory child abuse and mandatory dependent adult abuse 25 reporter training and certification requirements. 26 provides that the workgroup shall consist of representatives 27 from the departments of human services, education, and public 28 health and other experts the department of human services 29 deems necessary. The workgroup is required to develop 30 interdepartmental strategies for improving mandatory child 31 abuse and mandatory dependent adult abuse reporter training 32 and certification requirements and submit a report with 33 recommendations to the governor and the general assembly on or 34 before December 14, 2018.
