A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the coordination of enforcement activities

- officers, and including effective date provisions.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 321.477, subsection 1, Code 2018, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 1. The department may designate by resolution certain of its
- 4 employees upon each of whom there is conferred the authority
- 5 of a peace officer to enforce all laws of the state including
- 6 but not limited to the rules and regulations of the department.
- 7 Employees designated as peace officers pursuant to this
- 8 section shall have the same powers, duties, privileges, and
- 9 immunities conferred by law on peace officers for relating to
- 10 the enforcement of all laws of this state and the apprehension
- ll of violators.
- 12 Sec. 2. Section 321.477, Code 2018, is amended by adding the
- 13 following new subsection:
- 14 NEW SUBSECTION. 5A. The department and the department
- 15 of public safety shall coordinate to provide effective and
- 16 efficient enforcement of all laws of the state, including any
- 17 related regulatory actions.
- 18 Sec. 3. REPEAL. 2017 Iowa Acts, chapter 149, section 4, is
- 19 repealed.
- 20 Sec. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate
- 21 importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 22 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 24 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 25 Under current law, the department of transportation (DOT)
- 26 is authorized to designate by resolution certain of its
- 27 employees upon each of whom there is conferred the authority
- 28 of a peace officer to enforce all laws of the state including
- 29 but not limited to the rules and regulations of the DOT.
- 30 Employees designated as peace officers in this manner have
- 31 the same powers conferred by law on peace officers for the
- 32 enforcement of all laws of this state and the apprehension
- 33 of violators. This bill amends current law to specify that
- 34 employees designated as peace officers in this manner have the
- 35 same powers, duties, privileges, and immunities conferred by

- 1 law on peace officers relating to the enforcement of all laws
- 2 of this state and the apprehension of violators.
- 3 The bill provides that the DOT and the department of public
- 4 safety are required to coordinate to provide effective and
- 5 efficient enforcement of all laws of the state, including any
- 6 related regulatory actions.
- 7 In 2017, the general assembly amended Code section 321.477
- 8 to specify the powers, duties, and limitations of such
- 9 employees. Under the terms of the legislation, the amended
- 10 language is set to be repealed effective July 1, 2018. Because
- 11 the bill amends language enacted in 2017, the bill repeals the
- 12 future repeal provision. The bill takes effect upon enactment.
