## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act establishing requirements relating to the use
- 2 and identification of open educational resources by
- 3 postsecondary educational institutions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## S.F. 2362

- 1 Section 1. Section 260C.14, Code 2018, is amended by adding
- 2 the following new subsection:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 25. Identify the courses that will utilize
- 4 open educational resources where the community college provides
- 5 information or mechanisms for course registration, which
- 6 may be on the internet. For purposes of this section, "open
- 7 educational resources" means materials used to support education
- 8 that are in the public domain or are under an open license and
- 9 that may be freely accessed, reused, modified, and shared,
- 10 including but not limited to instructional materials, tests,
- 11 course syllabi, and textbooks.
- 12 Sec. 2. Section 261.2, subsection 11, Code 2018, is amended
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 ll. Require any postsecondary institution whose students
- 15 are eligible for or who receive financial assistance under
- 16 programs administered by the commission to transmit do all of
- 17 the following:
- 18 a. Transmit annually to the commission information about the
- 19 numbers of minority students enrolled in and minority faculty
- 20 members employed at the institution. The commission shall
- 21 compile and report the information collected to the general
- 22 assembly, the governor, and the legislative services agency by
- 23 March 1 annually.
- 24 b. Identify the courses that will utilize open educational
- 25 resources, as defined in section 260C.14, subsection 25, where
- 26 the institution provides information or mechanisms for course
- 27 registration, which may be on the internet.
- 28 Sec. 3. Section 262.9, Code 2018, is amended by adding the
- 29 following new subsection:
- 30 NEW SUBSECTION. 39. Direct each institution of higher
- 31 learning under its control to identify the courses that will
- 32 utilize open educational resources, as defined in section
- 33 260C.14, subsection 25, where the institution provides
- 34 information or mechanisms for course registration, which may be
- 35 on the internet. In addition, each institution shall develop

- 1 and implement, upon receiving board approval, a five-year plan
- 2 to increase the number of courses utilizing open educational
- 3 resources. The plan shall include metrics and goals for the
- 4 percentage of courses that utilize open educational resources.
- 5 Prior to approving a plan under this subsection, the board
- 6 shall determine whether the plan is sustainable beyond the
- 7 initial five-year implementation and whether the plan will
- 8 effectively reduce students' textbook and instructional
- 9 materials costs.
- 10 EXPLANATION
- 11 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 12 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 13 This bill establishes requirements relating to the use
- 14 and identification of open educational resources by Iowa's
- 15 postsecondary institutions.
- 16 Community colleges, postsecondary institutions whose
- 17 students receive financial assistance administered by the
- 18 college student aid commission, and regents universities
- 19 are directed to identify the courses that will utilize
- 20 open educational resources, where the institution provides
- 21 information on mechanisms for course registration, which may
- 22 be on the internet. Open educational resources are defined
- 23 as materials used to support education that are in the public
- 24 domain or are under an open license and that may be freely
- 25 accessed, reused, modified, and shared, including but not
- 26 limited to instructional materials, tests, course syllabi, and
- 27 textbooks.
- 28 In addition, regents universities must develop and
- 29 implement, upon receiving state board of regents approval, a
- 30 five-year plan to increase the number of courses utilizing open
- 31 educational materials.
