A BILL FOR

1 An Act authorizing Carroll and Clay counties to issue driver's
2 licenses, nonoperator's identification cards, and persons
3 with disabilities identification devices, and including
4 effective date provisions.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 321M.3, Code 2017, is amended to read as
2 follows:

3 **321M.3 Authorization to issue licenses.**

11 Keokuk, Kossuth, Lee, Louisa, Lucas, Lyon, Madison, Mahaska,
12 Marion, Mills, Mitchell, Monona, Monroe, Montgomery, O'Brien,
13 Osceola, Page, Palo Alto, Plymouth, Pocahontas, Poweshiek,
14 Ringgold, Sac, Shelby, Sioux, Tama, Taylor, Union, Van Buren,
15 Warren, Washington, Wayne, Winnebago, Winneshiek, Worth,
16 and Wright counties shall be authorized to issue driver's
17 licenses, nonoperator's identification cards, and persons with
18 disabilities identification devices on a permanent basis,
19 provided that such counties continue to meet the department's
20 standards for issuance.

21 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT. This Act, being deemed of
22 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

23 EXPLANATION

24 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
25 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

26 Code section 321M.3 authorizes certain counties to issue
27 driver's licenses, nonoperator's identification cards, and
28 persons with disabilities identification devices, provided the
29 counties continue to meet the department of transportation's
30 standards for issuance. This bill adds Carroll and Clay
31 counties to the list of authorized counties. The bill takes
32 effect upon enactment.
