A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the issuance of birth certificates and
- providing for a repeal.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

S.F. 441

- 1 Section 1. Section 144.13A, subsections 1 and 2, Code 2017,
- 2 are amended to read as follows:
- 3 1. The state registrar shall charge the parent a fee of
- 4 twenty dollars for the registration of a certificate of birth
- 5 as follows:
- 6 a. Beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2005, a fee
- 7 of fifteen dollars.
- 8 b. Beginning July 1, 2005, a fee of twenty dollars.
- 9 2. The state registrar shall charge the parent a separate
- 10 fee established under section 144.46 for a certified copy of
- 11 the certificate. The certified copy shall include all of the
- 12 information included in the original certificate of birth and
- 13 shall be letter-sized. The certified copy shall be mailed to
- 14 the parent by the state registrar. The mailing of a certified
- 15 copy of the certificate to a biological parent shall not be
- 16 precluded by the execution of a release of custody under
- 17 chapter 600A, and, upon request, a biological parent shall be
- 18 provided with a certified copy of the certificate unless the
- 19 parental rights of the biological parent are terminated.
- Sec. 2. Section 144.13A, Code 2017, is amended by adding the
- 21 following new subsection:
- 22 NEW SUBSECTION. 2A. a. If, during the period between
- 23 May 1993 and October 2009, a parent was issued a smaller than
- 24 letter-sized certified copy of the certificate of birth under
- 25 this section, which did not include all of the information
- 26 included in the original certificate of birth, upon request
- 27 of a parent, the department shall mail to the parent a single
- 28 letter-sized certified copy replacement that includes all
- 29 of the information provided in the original certificate of
- 30 birth. A parent shall not be required to exchange the smaller
- 31 certified copy for the larger certified copy replacement, but
- 32 may retain the smaller certified copy.
- 33 b. Notwithstanding the amount of the fee charged under
- 34 subsection 2, the state registrar shall not charge a fee
- 35 for the issuance of a single letter-sized certified copy of

- 1 the certificate of birth requested by a parent under this
- 2 subsection.
- 3 c. This subsection shall not apply if a new certificate of
- 4 birth was substituted for the original certificate of birth
- 5 pursuant to section 144.24.
- d. The department shall post the application form and
- 7 instructions for requesting a letter-sized certified copy
- 8 replacement as specified in this subsection on the department's
- 9 internet site. This paragraph is repealed June 30, 2022.
- 10 EXPLANATION
- 11 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 13 This bill relates to the certified copy of a certificate
- 14 of birth mailed to a parent by the state registrar following
- 15 registration of the certificate of birth.
- 16 The bill updates outdated language relating to the fee
- 17 charged a parent for registration of a certificate of birth by
- 18 eliminating the reference to the fee charged during the period
- 19 ending June 30, 2005, and retaining the current fee which is
- 20 \$20.
- 21 The bill provides that the certified copy of a certificate of
- 22 birth sent to a parent shall include all information included
- 23 in the original certificate of birth and be letter-sized.
- 24 Additionally, if a parent was issued a certified copy of the
- 25 certificate of birth that is smaller than letter-sized and does
- 26 not include all of the information provided in the original
- 27 certificate of birth during the period between May 1993 and
- 28 October 2009, upon request of the parent, the state registrar
- 29 shall mail to the parent one letter-sized certified copy that
- 30 includes all of the information provided in the original
- 31 certificate of birth. Notwithstanding the amount of the fee
- 32 regularly charged for the certificate of birth issued to a
- 33 parent, the bill directs that the state registrar shall not
- 34 charge the parent a fee for the certified copy requested by and
- 35 mailed to the parent under the bill.

S.F. 441

- 1 The bill directs the department of public health to post
- 2 the application form and the instructions for requesting the
- 3 replacement certified copy on the department's internet site.
- 4 This provision is repealed June 30, 2022.
