

Senate Resolution 106 - Introduced

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 106

BY SMITH

1 A Resolution amending the permanent rules of the senate
2 for the eighty-seventh general assembly relating to
3 appointments subject to confirmation by the senate.

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, That Rule 59,
5 unnumbered paragraph 4, permanent rules of the senate,
6 as adopted by the senate during the 2017 Session in
7 Senate Resolution 3, is amended to read as follows:

8 Within the three (3) legislative days after an
9 appointment has been referred to the rules and
10 administration committee, any ten senators may require
11 that the nominee be assigned to an appropriate standing
12 committee by filing a written, signed request therefor
13 with the chairperson of the rules and administration
14 committee. The committee chair shall refer the
15 appointment to a subcommittee within ~~one (1)~~ three
16 (3) legislative ~~day~~ days after a standing committee
17 receives an appointment for further investigation,
18 publishing notice of such assignment in the senate
19 journal for the next legislative day. Within ten (10)
20 legislative days after a standing committee receives an
21 appointment for further investigation, the subcommittee
22 shall file its report with the standing committee.
