SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 125

1 A Resolution recognizing and congratulating Andie
2 Dominick on winning the 2018 Pulitzer Prize in
3 editorial writing.

4 WHEREAS, Ms. Dominick has been an editorial writer
5 for the Des Moines Register since 2001, writing
6 numerous editorials on health care policy in Iowa; and

7 WHEREAS, Ms. Dominick was awarded the 2018 Pulitzer
8 Prize in editorial writing for her editorials on the
9 implementation and effects of managed care for Medicaid
10 and other significant health care issues in Iowa; and

11 WHEREAS, Ms. Dominick is one of seven Iowans
12 in history to win the Pulitzer Prize in editorial
13 writing; and

14 WHEREAS, the Pulitzer Prize Board praised Ms.
15 Dominick's work for "examining in a clear, indignant
16 voice, free of cliché or sentimentality, the damaging
17 consequences for poor Iowa residents of privatizing the
18 state's administration of Medicaid"; and

19 WHEREAS, Ms. Dominick has long shown a passion for
20 writing on health care and related matters, including a
21 series of editorials on professional licensing in Iowa
22 for which she was a Pulitzer Prize finalist in 2014 and
23 a memoir on growing up with diabetes; and

24 WHEREAS, Ms. Dominick's editorials were based on
25 extensive, collaborative, and factual reporting by her
26 and other members of the Des Moines Register's newsroom
27 staff; NOW THEREFORE,
