

**Senate Study Bill 1004 - Introduced**

**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act restricting the regulatory authority of the Iowa  
2 utilities board with regard to municipal utility  
3 disconnection of service requirements.  
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 476.1B, subsection 1, paragraph e, Code  
2 2017, is amended to read as follows:

3 e. Disconnection of service, as set forth in [section 476.20](#),  
4 subsections 1 through 4.

EXPLANATION

The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with

8 This bill relates to the regulatory authority of the Iowa  
9 utilities board with regard to municipal utility disconnection  
10 procedures.

11 Currently, Code section 476.1B provides that a municipally  
12 owned utility is not subject to regulation by the Iowa  
13 utilities board, subject to certain specified exceptions. One  
14 such exception is with regard to disconnection of service, as  
15 provided in Code section 476.20.

16 The bill modifies this reference to Code section 476.20 to  
17 limit the applicability of board regulation to subsections  
18 1 through 4 of the Code section. This renders provisions  
19 contained in Code section 476.20, subsection 5, regarding the  
20 board establishing rules relating to deposits which may be  
21 required by a utility for the initiation or reinstatement of  
22 service, inapplicable to municipal utilities.
