A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act permitting motor vehicles to stand unattended without 2 first stopping the engine.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 321.362, Code 2017, is amended to read 2 as follows:

3 321.362 Unattended motor vehicle.

No A person driving or in charge of a motor vehicle shall
<u>not</u> permit it <u>the vehicle</u> to stand unattended without first
stopping the engine, or when standing upon any perceptible
grade without effectively setting the brake thereon and turning
the front wheels to the curb or side of the highway.

EXPLANATION

10The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with11the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

12 Current law prohibits a person from permitting a vehicle to 13 stand unattended without first stopping the engine, or without 14 effectively setting the brake and turning the front wheels to 15 the curb or side of the highway when the vehicle is standing 16 upon any perceptible grade. A violation of this provision is 17 punishable by a scheduled fine of \$20.

18 This bill eliminates the prohibition on permitting a motor 19 vehicle to stand unattended without first stopping the engine.
