A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to record retention by licensed motor vehicle
- 2 recyclers, and making a penalty applicable.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 321H.4A, Code 2017, is amended to read 2 as follows:
- 3 321H.4A National motor vehicle title information system 4 record retention.
- 5 l. A vehicle recycler licensed under this chapter and
- 6 subject to the requirements of 28 C.F.R. §25.56 shall register
- 7 with the national motor vehicle title information system.
- 8 2. a. Except as provided in paragraph "b", for any vehicle
- 9 subject to registration under chapter 321 purchased by a
- 10 vehicle recycler licensed under this chapter and subject to the
- 11 requirements of 28 C.F.R. §25.56, the vehicle recycler shall
- 12 comply with the reporting requirements of 28 C.F.R. §25.56
- 13 within two business days of purchasing the vehicle. Records of
- 14 the vehicle recycler's compliance shall be kept by the vehicle
- 15 recycler for at least three years after the purchase of the
- 16 vehicle, and shall be open for inspection by any peace officer
- 17 during normal business hours. The department shall adopt rules
- 18 to implement this section, including but not limited to rules
- 19 requiring the submission and retention of records not required
- 20 by 28 C.F.R. §25.56.
- 21 b. Paragraph "a" does not apply to a vehicle that has
- 22 been crushed or flattened by mechanical means in such a way
- 23 that it no longer resembles the vehicle described by the
- 24 certificate of title if the vehicle recycler who purchased the
- 25 vehicle verifies that the seller of the vehicle has met the
- 26 requirements of paragraph "a". The department shall adopt rules
- 27 relating to the form of the verification, and the manner in
- 28 which the verification shall be retained.
- 29 3. A vehicle recycler licensed under this chapter that sells
- 30 a motor vehicle with a salvage certificate of title or junking
- 31 certificate shall retain for three years after the sale of the
- 32 vehicle an electronic record of all of the following:
- 33 a. The vehicle's make, model, model year, vehicle
- 34 identification number, and, if available, current odometer
- 35 reading.

- 1 b. The name and address of the purchaser.
- 2 c. The purchaser's unique number issued to the purchaser
- 3 through the national motor vehicle title information system,
- 4 or if the purchaser has not been issued such a number, the
- 5 purchaser's driver's license or nonoperator's identification
- 6 card number.
- 7 EXPLANATION
- 8 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 9 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 10 This bill requires a licensed vehicle recycler that sells
- 11 a vehicle with a salvage certificate of title or junking
- 12 certificate to retain for three years after the sale of
- 13 the vehicle an electronic record of the vehicle's make,
- 14 model, model year, vehicle identification number, and, if
- 15 available, current odometer reading; the name and address of
- 16 the purchaser; and the purchaser's unique number issued to the
- 17 purchaser through the national motor vehicle title information
- 18 system, or if the purchaser has not been issued such a
- 19 number, the purchaser's driver's license or nonoperator's
- 20 identification card number. By operation of law, a violation
- 21 of these provisions is a simple misdemeanor punishable by
- 22 a fine of not less than \$250 nor more than \$1,500 or by
- 23 imprisonment not to exceed 30 days.
