A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the provision of supported community living
- 2 services under Medicaid home and community-based services
- waivers, and including effective date and retroactive
- 4 applicability provisions.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. MEDICAID HOME AND COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES
- 2 WAIVERS SUPPORTED COMMUNITY LIVING SERVICES IN HOME OF
- 3 FAMILY MEMBER OR PERSON LEGALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE MEMBER -
- 4 REIMBURSEMENT.
- 5 l. Beginning March 1, 2017, the department of human services
- 6 shall make supported community living services available at a
- 7 daily rate to members living in the home of a family member
- 8 or of a person legally responsible for the member, who is the
- 9 provider of the community living services.
- 10 2. The department shall ensure that the provider meets the
- ll provider qualifications specified for the service provided,
- 12 that there is a properly executed provider agreement, and that
- 13 the family member or person legally responsible for the member
- 14 has a unique ability to meet the needs of the member.
- 15 3. The department shall ensure that the services provided
- 16 by a person who is legally responsible for the member are
- 17 deemed extraordinary care and that the provision of care by
- 18 the legally responsible person is in the best interest of the $\ensuremath{\mathsf{I}}$
- 19 member.
- 20 4. For the purposes of this section, "family member"
- 21 includes a person related to the member by consanguinity or
- 22 affinity, including but not limited to a sibling of the member
- 23 or a parent of an adult member; "a person legally responsible
- 24 for the member" includes a parent of a member who is a minor
- 25 or the spouse of a member; and "extraordinary care" means care
- 26 exceeding the range of activities that a legally responsible
- 27 individual would ordinarily perform in the household on behalf
- 28 of a person without a disability or chronic illness of the
- 29 same age, and which care is necessary to ensure the health and
- 30 welfare of the member and to avoid institutionalization.
- 31 5. A family member or person legally responsible for the
- 32 member in whose home the member lives and who is providing
- 33 supported community living services under an exception to
- 34 policy on or before the effective date of this Act, shall
- 35 be allowed to continue to provide the services and to be

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- 1 reimbursed at the daily rate in effect on the effective date of
- 2 this Act until such time as the family member or person legally
- 3 responsible for the member transitions to being a supported
- 4 community living services provider in accordance with this Act.
- 5 6. The department shall amend any Medicaid managed care
- 6 contract, shall amend or adopt administrative rules pursuant to
- 7 chapter 17A as necessary, and shall seek any federal approval
- 8 necessary to amend home and community-based services waivers to
- 9 comply with this section, effective March 1, 2017.
- 10 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT. This Act, being deemed of
- 11 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 12 Sec. 3. RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY. This Act applies
- 13 retroactively to March 1, 2017.
- 14 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 17 This bill directs the department of human services,
- 18 beginning March 1, 2017, to make available under Medicaid
- 19 home and community-based services waivers the provision
- 20 of and a daily rate reimbursement for supported community
- 21 living services in the home of a family member or of a person
- 22 legally responsible for the member, who is the provider of the
- 23 community living services.
- 24 The department of human services shall ensure that the
- 25 provider meets the provider qualifications specified for the
- 26 service provided, that there is a properly executed provider
- 27 agreement, and that the family member or person legally
- 28 responsible for the member has a unique ability to meet the
- 29 needs of the member. The department of human services shall
- 30 also ensure that the services provided by a person who is
- 31 legally responsible for the member are deemed extraordinary
- 32 care and that the provision of care by the legally responsible
- 33 person is in the best interest of the member.
- 34 The bill defines "family member", "a person legally
- 35 responsible for the member", and "extraordinary care".

- 1 The bill also provides that a family member or person legally
- 2 responsible for the member in whose home the member lives and
- 3 who is providing supported community living services under an
- 4 exception to policy on or before the effective date of the
- 5 bill, shall be allowed to continue to provide the services and
- 6 to be reimbursed at the daily rate in effect on the effective
- 7 date of the bill until such time as the family member or person
- 8 legally responsible for the member transitions to being a
- 9 supported community living services provider in accordance with
- 10 the bill.
- 11 The department of human services shall amend any Medicaid
- 12 managed care contract, shall amend or adopt any administrative
- 13 rules as necessary, and shall seek any federal approval
- 14 necessary to amend existing Medicaid home and community-based
- 15 services waivers to comply with the bill effective March 1,
- 16 2017.
- 17 The bill takes effect upon enactment and is retroactively
- 18 applicable to March 1, 2017.
