

Senate Study Bill 3139 - Introduced

A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the sale of motor homes on Sundays.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 322.3, subsection 9, Code 2018, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 9. A person licensed under **this chapter** shall not, either
4 directly or through an agent, salesperson, or employee, engage
5 in this state, or represent or advertise that the person is
6 engaged or intends to engage in this state, in the business of
7 buying or selling at retail new or used motor vehicles, other
8 than mobile homes more than eight feet in width or more than
9 thirty-two feet in length as defined in **section 321.1, or motor**
10 **homes as defined in section 321.1**, on the first day of the
11 week, commonly known and designated as Sunday.

12 EXPLANATION

13 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
14 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

15 Under current law, a person licensed under Code chapter
16 322 (motor vehicle manufacturers, distributors, wholesalers,
17 and dealers) is prohibited from, either directly or through
18 an agent, salesperson, or employee, engaging in this state,
19 or representing or advertising that the person is engaged or
20 intends to engage in this state, in the business of buying or
21 selling at retail new or used motor vehicles, other than mobile
22 homes more than eight feet in width or more than 32 feet in
23 length, on Sundays. This bill provides that such a person
24 may sell motor homes on Sundays. Under Code section 321.1, a
25 "motor home" is a motor vehicle designed as an integral unit to
26 be used as a conveyance upon the public streets and highways
27 and for use as a temporary or recreational dwelling, that has
28 certain permanently installed systems which meet American
29 national standards institute and national fire protection
30 association standards in effect on the date of manufacture.
