

**House File 2058 - Introduced**

HOUSE FILE 2058

**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act providing for repeal of the Iowa Code over a ten-year  
2 period and procedures for legislative review and  
3 reenactment.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. IOWA CODE TEN-YEAR REPEAL — LEGISLATIVE REVIEW  
2 AND REENACTMENT.

3 1. The following titles of the Iowa Code are repealed as of  
4 the following dates:

- 5 a. Titles I and II, July 1, 2022.
- 6 b. Titles III and IV, July 1, 2023.
- 7 c. Titles V and XI, July 1, 2024.
- 8 d. Title VI, July 1, 2025.
- 9 e. Title VII, July 1, 2026.
- 10 f. Title VIII, July 1, 2027.
- 11 g. Title IX, July 1, 2028.
- 12 h. Title X, July 1, 2029.
- 13 i. Titles XII and XIII, July 1, 2030.
- 14 j. Titles XIV, XV, and XVI, July 1, 2031.

15 2. During the fiscal year prior to the repeal of a title of  
16 the Iowa Code pursuant to subsection 1, the general assembly  
17 shall, pursuant to procedures established by the legislative  
18 council, review the title to determine any amendments that may  
19 be necessary or appropriate. Such review may include a review  
20 of any uncodified provisions enacted by the general assembly  
21 that pertain to a title subject to such review.

22 3. The general assembly may, by enactment of one or more  
23 bills, reenact any title of the Iowa Code repealed or scheduled  
24 to be repealed pursuant to subsection 1, in whole or in part,  
25 with any amendments the general assembly may find necessary or  
26 appropriate after review pursuant to subsection 2.

27 EXPLANATION

28 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with  
29 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

30 This bill provides for the repeal of titles of the Code over  
31 a 10-year period beginning July 1, 2022.

32 The bill directs the general assembly, pursuant to  
33 procedures established by the legislative council, to review a  
34 title during the fiscal year prior to its repeal to determine  
35 any amendments that may be necessary or appropriate.

1 The bill provides that the general assembly may, by  
2 enactment of one or more bills, reenact any title repealed or  
3 scheduled to be repealed pursuant to the bill, in whole or  
4 in part, with any amendments the general assembly may find  
5 necessary or appropriate after such review.

6 The schedule for repeal of titles pursuant to the bill is as  
7 follows:

8 Titles I (state sovereignty and management) and II  
9 (elections and official duties), July 1, 2022.

10 Titles III (public services and regulation) and IV (public  
11 health), July 1, 2023.

12 Titles V (agriculture) and XI (natural resources), July 1,  
13 2024.

14 Title VI (human services), July 1, 2025.

15 Title VII (education and cultural affairs), July 1, 2026.

16 Title VIII (transportation), July 1, 2027.

17 Title IX (local government), July 1, 2028.

18 Title X (financial resources), July 1, 2029.

19 Titles XII (business entities) and XIII (commerce), July 1,  
20 2030.

21 Titles XIV (property), XV (judicial branch and judicial  
22 procedures), and XVI (criminal law and procedure), July 1,  
23 2031.
