A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the definition of infant and toddler for the
2 purposes of child care provider reimbursement rates under
3 the state child care assistance program.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. STATE CHILD CARE ASSISTANCE PROVIDER
2 REIMBURSEMENT — DEFINITION OF INFANT AND TODDLER. The
3 department of human services shall amend its administrative
4 rules pursuant to chapter 17A to define "infant and toddler"
5 as a child between the ages of two weeks and three years for
6 purposes of reimbursement rates for infant and toddler child
7 care providers reimbursed under the state child care assistance
8 program.

9 EXPLANATION

10 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
11 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

12 This bill directs the department of human services to amend
13 its administrative rules to define "infant and toddler" as
14 a child between the ages of two weeks and three years for
15 purposes of reimbursement rates for infant and toddler child
16 care providers reimbursed under the state child care assistance
17 program.
