A BILL FOR

1 An Act increasing the minimum age for persons to be eligible
2 for issuance of a special minor's driver's license.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 321.194, subsection 1, unnumbered
2 paragraph 1, Code 2020, is amended to read as follows:

3 The department may issue a class C or M driver's license to a
4 person between the ages of ~~fourteen~~ fifteen and eighteen years
5 if all of the following apply:

6 EXPLANATION

7 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
8 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

9 Under current law, the department of transportation may
10 issue a class C or M special minor's driver's license to a
11 person between the ages of 14 and 18 years under certain
12 conditions. This bill increases the minimum age to 15 years.
13 A person who is age 14 is still eligible for an instruction
14 permit under Code section 321.180B and a motorized bicycle
15 license under Code section 321.189(7).
