A BILL FOR

1 An Act requiring high school students to participate in
2 extracurricular interscholastic athletic practices,
3 contests, or competitions based on biological sex as
4 determined at birth.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 280.13D Participation in
2 extracurricular interscholastic athletic practices, contests, or
3 competitions — sex at birth.

4 Notwithstanding section 216.9, a public or nonpublic high
5 school student shall only participate in an extracurricular
6 interscholastic athletic practice, contest, or competition that
7 is designated for the student's biological sex as determined at
8 birth.

9 EXPLANATION

10 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
11 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

12 This bill provides that, notwithstanding a specified
13 provision of state law to the contrary, a public or
14 nonpublic high school student shall only participate in an
15 extracurricular interscholastic athletic practice, contest, or
16 competition that is designated for the student's biological sex
17 as determined at birth.
