A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the Iowa core standards for social studies
- and providing for regular review and revision of the
- 3 standards and related administrative rules.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. Section 256.7, subsection 26, paragraph a, Code
- 2 2020, is amended by adding the following new subparagraph:
- 3 NEW SUBPARAGRAPH. (5) By July 1, 2021, the rules
- 4 establishing the Iowa core standards for social studies for
- 5 kindergarten through grade twelve shall include the history,
- 6 contributions, and perspectives of populations in accordance
- 7 with section 256.9, subsection 60.
- 8 Sec. 2. Section 256.9, Code 2020, is amended by adding the
- 9 following new subsection:
- 10 NEW SUBSECTION. 60. a. By May 1, 2021, review and revise
- 11 the Iowa core standards to ensure that the content anchor
- 12 standards for United States history, geography, economics,
- 13 civics, and government include the histories, contributions,
- 14 and perspectives of all of the following populations:
- 15 (1) Native Americans.
- 16 (2) People of African, Asian, Pacific Islander, Hispanic,
- 17 Latino, or Middle Eastern heritage.
- 18 (3) Women.
- 19 (4) Persons with disabilities.
- 20 (5) Immigrants or refugees.
- 21 (6) Persons who are or who identify as lesbian, gay,
- 22 bisexual, or transgender.
- 23 b. Provide technical assistance and implementation
- 24 strategies to school districts if revisions made pursuant to
- 25 this subsection require curriculum and instruction changes.
- 26 c. Regularly review and recommend changes as necessary to
- 27 the rules adopted by the state board establishing the Iowa
- 28 core standards for social studies pursuant to section 256.7,
- 29 subsection 26, paragraph \tilde{a} , subparagraph (5), and section
- 30 256.7, subsection 28.
- 31 Sec. 3. STATE MANDATE FUNDING SPECIFIED. In accordance
- 32 with section 25B.2, subsection 3, the state cost of requiring
- 33 compliance with any state mandate included in this Act shall
- 34 be paid by a school district from state school foundation aid
- 35 received by the school district under section 257.16. This

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- 1 specification of the payment of the state cost shall be deemed
- 2 to meet all of the state funding-related requirements of
- 3 section 25B.2, subsection 3, and no additional state funding
- 4 shall be necessary for the full implementation of this Act
- 5 by and enforcement of this Act against all affected school
- 6 districts.
- 7 EXPLANATION
- 8 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 9 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 10 This bill requires the director of the department of
- 11 education to review and revise the Iowa core standards for
- 12 social studies by May 1, 2021, and requires the state board
- 13 of education to adopt rules by July 1, 2021, based on the
- 14 director's revisions.
- 15 The director must ensure that the content anchor standards
- 16 for United States history, geography, economics, civics,
- 17 and government include the histories, contributions, and
- 18 perspectives of Native Americans; people of African, Asian,
- 19 Pacific Islander, Hispanic, Latino, or Middle Eastern heritage;
- 20 women; persons with disabilities; immigrants or refugees; and
- 21 persons who are or who identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, or
- 22 transgender.
- 23 The director must also provide technical assistance and
- 24 implementation strategies to school districts if the revisions
- 25 require curriculum and instruction changes.
- 26 The director is further tasked with regularly reviewing and
- 27 recommending administrative rule changes as necessary relating
- 28 to the Iowa core standards for social studies.
- 29 The bill may include a state mandate as defined in Code
- 30 section 25B.3. The bill requires that the state cost of
- 31 any state mandate included in the bill be paid by a school
- 32 district from state school foundation aid received by the
- 33 school district under Code section 257.16. The specification
- 34 is deemed to constitute state compliance with any state mandate
- 35 funding-related requirements of Code section 25B.2. The

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- 1 inclusion of this specification is intended to reinstate the
- 2 requirement of political subdivisions to comply with any state
- 3 mandates included in the bill.
