A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act creating a city enforcement surcharge.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 364.26 City enforcement surcharge.
- 2 A city council may by resolution allow a five dollar city
- 3 enforcement surcharge to be assessed pursuant to section 911.5.
- 4 Sec. 2. Section 602.8102, subsection 135A, Code 2020, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 135A. Assess the surcharges provided by sections 911.1,
- 7 911.2, 911.2A, 911.2B, 911.2C, 911.3, and 911.4, and 911.5.
- 8 Sec. 3. Section 602.8108, subsection 8, Code 2020, is
- 9 amended to read as follows:
- 10 8. a. The clerk of the district court shall remit all
- 11 moneys collected from the county enforcement surcharge pursuant
- 12 to section 911.4 to the county where the citation was issued
- 13 for deposit in the county general fund no later than the
- 14 fifteenth day of each month.
- 15 b. The clerk of the district court shall remit all moneys
- 16 collected from the city enforcement surcharge pursuant to
- 17 section 911.5 to the city of the peace officer who issued the
- 18 citation for deposit in the city general fund no later than the
- 19 fifteenth day of each month.
- Sec. 4. Section 805.8, subsection 1, unnumbered paragraph
- 21 1, Code 2020, is amended to read as follows:
- 22 Except as otherwise indicated, violations of sections of
- 23 the Code specified in sections 805.8A, 805.8B, and 805.8C
- 24 are scheduled violations, and the scheduled fine for each of
- 25 those violations is as provided in those sections, whether the
- 26 violation is of state law or of a county or city ordinance. The
- 27 criminal penalty surcharge required by section 911.1, and the
- 28 county enforcement surcharge required by section 911.4, and
- 29 the city enforcement surcharge required by section 911.5, if
- 30 applicable, shall be added to the scheduled fine.
- 31 Sec. 5. Section 903.1, subsection 4, Code 2020, is amended
- 32 to read as follows:
- The surcharges required by sections 911.1, 911.2,
- 34 911.2A, 911.3, and 911.4, and 911.5 shall be added to a fine
- 35 imposed on a misdemeanant as provided in those sections,

- 3 Sec. 6. Section 911.4, subsection 2, Code 2020, is amended 4 to read as follows:
- 5 2. Pursuant to section 602.8108, subsection 8, paragraph
- 6 $\underline{\tilde{a}''}$, the surcharge shall be deposited in the county general fund 7 of the county where the citation was issued.
- 8 Sec. 7. NEW SECTION. 911.5 City enforcement surcharge.
- 9 l. If a city has adopted a resolution pursuant to section
- 10 364.26 and a court imposes a fine or forfeiture for any simple
- 11 misdemeanor punishable as a scheduled violation pursuant to
- 12 a citation issued by a peace officer appointed by the city,
- 13 the court or the clerk of the district court shall assess a
- 14 surcharge in the amount of five dollars for each applicable
- 15 violation in addition to any fine, forfeiture, or other
- 16 surcharge.
- 2. Pursuant to section 602.8108, subsection 8, paragraph
- 18 "b", the surcharge shall be deposited in the city general fund
- 19 of the city of the peace officer where the citation was issued.
- 3. The surcharge is subject to the provisions of chapter 909
- 21 governing the payment and collection of fines as provided in
- 22 section 909.8.
- 23 EXPLANATION
- 24 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 25 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 26 Under current law, a county may adopt a resolution to assess
- 27 a \$5 surcharge when a court imposes a fine or forfeiture for
- 28 any simple misdemeanor punishable as a scheduled violation
- 29 pursuant to a citation issued by a county sheriff. This bill
- 30 permits a city council to adopt a resolution allowing a \$5 city
- 31 enforcement surcharge when a court imposes a fine or forfeiture
- 32 for any simple misdemeanor punishable as a scheduled violation
- 33 pursuant to a citation issued by a city peace officer. The
- 34 surcharge shall be deposited in the city general fund of the
- 35 city peace officer who issued the citation.
