A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to expansion of the 1st five program statewide,  
2 and making an appropriation.  
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. 1ST FIVE HEALTHY MENTAL DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE  
2 — STATEWIDE EXPANSION. There is appropriated from the general  
3 fund of the state to the department of public health for the  
4 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020, and ending June 30, 2021,  
5 in addition to any other funds appropriated for the same  
6 initiative for the same fiscal year, the following amount or so  
7 much thereof as is necessary for the purposes designated:

8 To continue the department's initiative to provide for  
9 adequate developmental surveillance and screening during a  
10 child's first five years through the 1st five healthy mental  
11 development initiative by expanding the initiative statewide to  
12 include the remaining counties of Cherokee, Clinton, Ida, Iowa,  
13 Jackson, Johnson, Lyon, Plymouth, Scott, Sioux, and Woodbury:

15 EXPLANATION

16 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with  
17 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

18 This bill appropriates, in addition to any other funds  
19 appropriated for the same initiative for the same fiscal  
20 year, \$1.5 million from the general fund of the state to the  
21 department of public health for FY 2020-2021 to expand the 1st  
22 five healthy mental development initiative statewide to the  
23 remaining counties of Cherokee, Clinton, Ida, Iowa, Jackson,  
24 Johnson, Lyon, Plymouth, Scott, Sioux, and Woodbury.
