- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 702.6A Crime of violence.
- 2 A "crime of violence" means an offense that has as an element
- 3 of the offense the use, attempted use, or threatened use of
- 4 physical force or power against the person or property of
- 5 another.
- 6 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 702.20B Violence.
- 7 "Violence" means the intentional use of physical force or
- 8 power, threatened or actual, against oneself, another person,
- 9 or a group or community, which either results in or has a high
- 10 likelihood of resulting in injury, death, or psychological
- ll harm.
- 12 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 15 This bill defines the terms "crime of violence" and
- 16 "violence".
- 17 The bill provides that a crime of violence means an offense
- 18 that has as an element of the offense the use, attempted use,
- 19 or threatened use of physical force or power against the person
- 20 or property of another.
- 21 The bill defines violence as the intentional use of physical
- 22 force or power, threatened or actual, against oneself, another
- 23 person, or a group or community, which either results in
- 24 or has a high likelihood of resulting in injury, death, or
- 25 psychological harm.
