A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to Medicaid managed care for the long-term
- 2 services and supports population, and including effective
- 3 date provisions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. MEDICAID MANAGED CARE TRANSITION TO SINGULAR
- 2 MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATION ENTIRE LONG-TERM SERVICES AND
- 3 SUPPORTS POPULATION. The department of human services shall
- 4 do all of the following:
- Assign the entire long-term services and supports
- 6 population for administration of the Iowa high quality
- 7 health care initiative to a singular Medicaid managed care
- 8 organization that has an existing Medicaid managed care
- 9 contract with the state and had a Medicaid managed care
- 10 membership in December 2018 of between one hundred eighty-five
- 11 thousand and two hundred twenty thousand.
- 12 2. Provide written notice in accordance with the
- 13 termination provisions of the contract, to the other Medicaid
- 14 managed care organizations with whom the department has
- 15 executed a contract to administer the Iowa high quality health
- 16 care initiative, to terminate such contracts as applicable to
- 17 the Medicaid long-term services and supports population. The
- 18 termination shall be effective upon the date of transition of
- 19 all long-term services and supports members to the singular
- 20 Medicaid managed care organization serving the entire long-term
- 21 services and supports population.
- 22 3. Develop a plan for the transition of administration of
- 23 the Iowa high quality health care initiative for the long-term
- 24 services and supports population to the singular Medicaid
- 25 managed care organization and submit the transition plan to
- 26 the council on human services and to the medical assistance
- 27 advisory council for review.
- 28 4. Seek any Medicaid state plan or waiver amendments
- 29 necessary to complete the transition.
- 30 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate
- 31 importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 32 EXPLANATION
- 33 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 34 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 35 This bill requires the department of human services (DHS)

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- 1 to assign the entire long-term services and supports (LTSS)
- 2 population for administration of the Iowa high quality
- 3 health care initiative to a singular Medicaid managed care
- 4 organization (MCO) that has an existing Medicaid managed
- 5 care contract with the state and had a Medicaid managed care
- 6 membership in December 2018 of between 185,000 and 220,000.
- 7 DHS is required to provide written notice in accordance with
- 8 the termination provisions of the contract, to the other
- 9 MCOs with whom DHS has executed a contract, to terminate
- 10 such contracts as applicable to the LTSS population. The
- 11 termination is effective upon the date of transition of all
- 12 LTSS members to the singular MCO. DHS is also required to
- 13 develop a plan for the transition of the LTSS population to the
- 14 singular MCO, to submit the transition plan to the council on
- 15 human services and to the medical assistance advisory council
- 16 for review, and to seek any Medicaid state plan or waiver
- 17 amendments necessary to complete the transition. The bill
- 18 takes effect upon enactment.
