## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the confidentiality of information filed
- 2 with the court used to secure an arrest warrant.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 804.29, subsection 2, Code 2019, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 2. However, during the period of confidentiality
- 4 in subsection 1, the information in the record may be
- 5 disseminated, without court order, during the course of
- 6 official duties to the following persons unless dissemination
- 7 is expressly restricted by court order:
- 8 a. A peace officer, or any other employee of a law
- 9 enforcement agency if allowed access pursuant to section 692.14
- 10 and if authorized in writing by the head of the agency.
- 11 b. An employee of the county attorney's office.
- 12 c. A judicial officer or other court employees.
- d. An employee of the department of corrections or judicial
- 14 district department of correctional services, if authorized by
- 15 the director of the department of corrections.
- 16 e. A private attorney appearing on behalf of the defendant
- 17 or an attorney appointed by the court to represent the
- 18 defendant.
- 19 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 22 This bill relates to the confidentiality of information
- 23 filed with the court used to secure an arrest warrant.
- 24 Current law specifies that information filed with the court
- 25 used to secure an arrest warrant shall be confidential until a
- 26 peace officer has made the arrest and has made the officer's
- 27 return on the warrant, or the defendant has made an initial
- 28 appearance in court, unless otherwise ordered by the court.
- 29 During the period of confidentiality, the information in the
- 30 record can be disseminated, without court order, to certain
- 31 listed individuals during the course of their official duties.
- 32 The bill provides that access to the confidential records
- 33 can be expressly restricted by court order.
- 34 The bill adds a private attorney appearing on behalf
- 35 of the defendant or an attorney appointed by the court to

- 1 represent the defendant to the list of individuals to whom
- 2 information filed with the court for the purpose of securing
- 3 a warrant for an arrest may be disseminated during the period
- ${\tt 4}$  of confidentiality, without court order, during the course of
