

House Study Bill 205 - Introduced

A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to federal funding inventories.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 8.22, subsection 1, paragraph b,
2 subparagraph (1), subparagraph division (e), Code 2019, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 (e) A statement of federal funds received in the form of
5 block or categorical grants which were not included in the
6 governor's budget for the previous fiscal year and a statement
7 of anticipated block grants and categorical grants. The budget
8 shall indicate how the federal funds will be used and the
9 programs to which they will be allocated. The amount of state
10 funds required to implement the programs to which the federal
11 funds will apply shall also be indicated. The departments
12 shall provide information to the director on the anticipated
13 federal block grants and categorical grants to be received on
14 or before November 1 of each year. The director shall use
15 this information and the federal funding inventories submitted
16 pursuant to section 8.23, subsection 3, to develop an annual
17 update of the statement of federal funds received which shall
18 be provided to the general assembly.

19 Sec. 2. Section 8.23, Code 2019, is amended by adding the
20 following new subsection:

21 NEW SUBSECTION. 3. a. In addition to the reporting
22 requirements set forth under section 8.44, on or before
23 November 15, all departments and establishments of the
24 government and the judicial branch shall transmit to the
25 department of management and the legislative services agency a
26 federal funding inventory for the previous fiscal year. The
27 format of the transmittal shall be specified by the legislative
28 services agency. A federal funding inventory shall include all
29 of the following:

30 (1) The aggregate amount of federal moneys received by the
31 agency in the previous fiscal year.

32 (2) The percentage of the total moneys received by
33 the agency in the previous fiscal year, including moneys
34 appropriated to the agency by the general assembly and moneys
35 from federal or other nonstate grants, receipts, and funds,

1 attributable to federal moneys received by the agency.

2 (3) A copy of any agreement or contract, including a
3 memorandum of understanding or maintenance of effort agreement,
4 between the agency and a federal agency or entity to receive
5 federal moneys for the previous fiscal year.

6 (4) A summary detailing the obligations imposed on the
7 agency as a condition to receiving federal moneys for the
8 previous fiscal year, including any required match using state
9 moneys, any required number of full-time equivalent positions,
10 and any other required resources or obligations incurred by the
11 agency, accompanied by a citation to the applicable federal
12 law, regulation, or grant provision, if any.

13 (5) A detailed description of the actions or results pledged
14 or guaranteed by the agency to receive federal moneys for the
15 previous fiscal year.

16 (6) One or more objectives, as set forth in state law, the
17 agency met or intended to meet by receiving the federal moneys,
18 accompanied by a citation to the applicable provision.

19 (7) A detailed list of federal moneys received by the
20 agency in the previous fiscal year that have a potential
21 or foreseeable date on which such moneys will no longer be
22 available from the federal government, accompanied by the
23 estimated date and a schedule of federal moneys expected to be
24 received by the agency until that date.

25 *b.* For purposes of this subsection, "*federal moneys*"
26 means any financial assistance received from the United
27 States government or any agency or entity thereof, whether
28 by contract, block grant, categorical grant, grant subsidy,
29 augmentation, reimbursement, or any other form.

30 EXPLANATION

31 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
32 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

33 This bill requires, on or before November 15, all executive
34 branch agencies and the judicial branch to transmit to the
35 department of management and the legislative services agency a

1 federal funding inventory for the previous fiscal year. The
2 format of the transmittal is to be specified by the legislative
3 services agency, and a federal funding inventory must include
4 all components as specified in the bill.

5 The federal funding inventories are to be used by the
6 director of the department of management in developing the
7 director's annual update of the statement of federal funds
8 received that is provided to the general assembly.
