A BILL FOR

1	An	Act expanding the national guard educational assistance
2		program to provide educational assistance to national guard
3		members who are enrolled in a curriculum leading to a doctor
4		of medicine degree or a doctor of osteopathic medicine
5		degree.
6	BE	IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 261.86, subsection 1, unnumbered 2 paragraph 1, Code 2019, is amended to read as follows: A national guard educational assistance program is 3 4 established to be administered by the college student aid 5 commission for members of the Iowa national guard who are 6 either enrolled as undergraduate students in a community 7 college, an institution of higher learning under the state 8 board of regents, or an accredited private institution, or 9 enrolled as postgraduate students in accredited medical or 10 osteopathic schools. The college student aid commission shall 11 adopt rules pursuant to chapter 17A to administer this section. 12 An individual is eligible for the national guard educational 13 assistance program if the individual meets all of the following 14 conditions: 15 Sec. 2. Section 261.86, subsection 1, paragraph d, Code 16 2019, is amended to read as follows: d. Is enrolled in and is maintaining satisfactory academic 17 18 progress as an either of the following: 19 (1) An undergraduate student in a community college as 20 defined in section 260C.2, an institution of higher learning 21 under the control of the board of regents, or an accredited 22 private institution as defined in section 261.9, and is 23 maintaining satisfactory academic progress. 24 (2) A postgraduate student enrolled in a school of medicine 25 accredited by the liaison committee on medical education or 26 an osteopathic medical school accredited by the commission on 27 osteopathic college accreditation of the American osteopathic 28 association in a curriculum leading to a doctor of medicine 29 degree or a doctor of osteopathic medicine degree. 30 Sec. 3. Section 261.86, subsection 3, Code 2019, is amended 31 by adding the following new paragraph: NEW PARAGRAPH. c. Notwithstanding paragraph "a", up to 32 33 five eligible members of the national guard annually, as 34 determined by the adjutant general, who meet the requirements 35 of subsection 1, paragraphs a'' through c'', e'' through g'',

LSB 2801YC (2) 88 kh/jh 1 and paragraph "d", subparagraph (2), shall receive educational 2 assistance under this section in an amount not to exceed 3 twenty thousand dollars annually for not more than four years. 4 Educational assistance under this paragraph is conditional on 5 the eligible member completing a residency program and serving 6 five years in the Iowa national guard as a medical corps 7 officer while practicing medicine in Iowa. If an eligible 8 member fails to fulfill the conditions of this paragraph, the 9 eligible member shall be subject to repayment to the commission 10 of the amount of educational assistance received under this 11 section plus interest as specified by rule.

13The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with14the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

15 This bill provides that up to five eligible members of the 16 national guard annually, as determined by the adjutant general, 17 who meet the requirements of the national guard educational 18 assistance program but who are enrolled in a postgraduate 19 course of study at an accredited school of medicine or at an 20 accredited osteopathic medical school leading to a doctor of 21 medicine degree or a doctor of osteopathic medicine degree 22 shall receive educational assistance in an amount not to exceed 23 \$20,000 annually for not more than four years.

The eligible member must then complete a residency program and serve five years in the Iowa national guard as a medical corps officer while practicing medicine in Iowa. A guard member who fails to fulfill these conditions must repay to the commission the amount of educational assistance received plus interest.
