## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act increasing the maximum allowable length for
- 2 stinger-steered automobile transporters.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 321.457, subsection 2, paragraph i, Code 2 2019, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 i. A stinger-steered automobile transporter shall not
- 4 have an overall length exceeding seventy-five eighty feet,
- 5 exclusive of retractable extensions used to support the load
- 6 and all other devices or appurtenances related to the safe and
- 7 efficient operation of the vehicle, except that the load may
- 8 extend up to three four feet beyond the front bumper and up to
- 9 four six feet beyond the rear bumper.
- 10 EXPLANATION
- 11 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 12 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 13 Under current law, Code section 321.457 prohibits a
- 14 stinger-steered automobile transporter from having an overall
- 15 length exceeding 75 feet, exclusive of retractable extensions
- 16 used to support the load and all other devices or appurtenances
- 17 related to the safe and efficient operation of the vehicle,
- 18 except that the load may extend up to three feet beyond the
- 19 front bumper and up to four feet beyond the rear bumper.
- 20 Federal law (49 U.S.C. §31111(b)(1)(G)) prohibits states from
- 21 prescribing or enforcing regulations that impose a vehicle
- 22 length limitation of less than 80 feet on stinger-steered
- 23 automobile transporters with a front overhang of less than four
- 24 feet and a rear overhang of less than six feet. Code section
- 25 321.1 defines "stinger-steered automobile transporter" to mean
- 26 any vehicle combination designed and used specifically for the
- 27 transport of assembled highway vehicles, recreational vehicles,
- 28 or boats in which the fifth wheel is located on a drop frame
- 29 located below and behind the rearmost axle of the power unit.
- 30 This bill increases the length limitation on stinger-steered
- 31 automobile transporters to 80 feet, and authorizes the load to
- 32 extend up to four feet beyond the front bumper and up to six
- 33 feet beyond the rear bumper.
- 34 A violation of Code section 321.457 is punishable by a
- 35 scheduled fine of \$200.
