A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the administration of city and school
- 2 elections.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 44.9, subsection 3, Code 2019, is amended
2 to read as follows:

3 3. In the office of the proper school board secretary, at 4 least thirty-five forty-two days before the day of a regularly 5 scheduled school election.

6 Sec. 2. Section 50.48, subsection 7, Code 2019, is amended 7 to read as follows:

7. If the election is an election held by a city which 8 9 is not the final election for the office in question, the 10 recount shall progress according to the times provided by this ll subsection. If this subsection applies, the canvass shall be 12 held by the second day after the election, the request for 13 a recount must be made by the third day after the election, 14 the board shall convene to conduct the recount by the sixth 15 day after the election, and the report shall be filed by the 16 eleventh day after the election conducted pursuant to section 17 50.24. The request for a recount must be made by the day after 18 the canvass, and the board shall convene for the first time not 19 later than the first Friday following the canvass. The report 20 shall be filed by the fourteenth day after the election. 21 Section 260C.12, subsection 1, as amended by 2017 Sec. 3.

22 Iowa Acts, chapter 155, section 2, is amended to read as 23 follows:

1. The board of directors of the merged area shall organize at the first regular meeting following the regular school election or at a special meeting called by the secretary of the board to organize the board in advance of the first regular meeting following the regular school election after the canvass for the regular school election. Organization of the board shall be effected by the election of a president and other officers from the board membership as board members determine. The board of directors shall appoint a secretary and a treasurer who shall each give bond as prescribed in section 29.201.2 and who shall each receive the salary determined by the 30.5 board. The secretary and treasurer shall perform duties under

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1 chapter 291 and additional duties the board of directors deems 2 necessary. However, the board may appoint one person to serve 3 as the secretary and treasurer. If one person serves as the 4 secretary and treasurer, only one bond is necessary for that 5 person. The frequency of meetings other than organizational 6 meetings shall be as determined by the board of directors but 7 the president or a majority of the members may call a special 8 meeting at any time.

9 Sec. 4. Section 260C.15, subsection 5, as amended by 2017 10 Iowa Acts, chapter 155, section 4, is amended to read as 11 follows:

12 5. The votes cast in the election shall be canvassed and 13 abstracts of the votes cast shall be certified as required by 14 section 277.20. In each county whose commissioner of elections 15 is responsible under section 47.2 for conducting elections 16 held for a merged area, the county board of supervisors shall 17 convene on the last Monday in November or at the last regular 18 board meeting in November, on the second Monday or Tuesday 19 after the day of the election to canvass the abstracts of votes 20 cast and declare the results of the voting. The commissioner 21 shall at once issue certificates of election to each person 22 declared elected, and shall certify to the merged area board in 23 substantially the manner prescribed by section 50.27 the result 24 of the voting on any public question submitted to the voters 25 of the merged area. Members elected to the board of directors 26 of a merged area shall qualify by taking the oath of office 27 prescribed in section 277.28.

28 Sec. 5. Section 376.9, subsection 1, Code 2019, is amended 29 to read as follows:

30 1. A runoff election may be held only for positions unfilled 31 because of failure of a sufficient number of candidates to 32 receive a majority vote in the regular city election. When a 33 council has chosen a runoff election in lieu of a primary, the 34 county board of supervisors shall publicly canvass the tally 35 lists of the vote cast in the regular city election, following

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1 the procedures prescribed in section 50.24, at a meeting to be 2 held on the second day following the regular city election, and 3 beginning no earlier than 1:00 p.m. on that day. Candidates 4 who do not receive a majority of the votes cast for an office, 5 but who receive the highest number of votes cast for that 6 office in the regular city election, to the extent of twice 7 the number of unfilled positions, are candidates in the runoff 8 election. Sec. 6. 9 2017 Iowa Acts, chapter 155, section 45, is amended 10 to read as follows: SEC. 45. TERM OF OFFICE - TRANSITION PROVISIONS. 11 12 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 260C.11 13 designating a term of four years for members of a board of 14 directors of a merged area, the term of office for a seat on a 15 board of directors filled at the regular school election held 16 on: September 8, 2015, shall expire November 5, 2019 upon 17 a. 18 the board's organizational meeting held pursuant to section 19 260C.12, subsection 1. 20 September 12, 2017, shall expire November 2, 2021 upon b. 21 the board's organizational meeting held pursuant to section 22 260C.12, subsection 1. 23 Notwithstanding the provisions of section 273.8, 2. 24 subsection 1, designating a term of four years for members of 25 a board of directors of an area education agency, the term of 26 office for a seat on a board of directors filled by election 27 in: September 2015 shall expire November 30, 2019. 28 a. 29 b. September 2017 shall expire November 30, 2021. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 274.7 30 3. 31 designating a term of four years for members of a board of 32 directors of a school district, the term of office for a seat 33 on a board of directors filled at the regular school election 34 held on: a. September 8, 2015, shall expire November 5, 2019 upon the 35

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1 board's organizational meeting held pursuant to section 279.1. 2 b. September 12, 2017, shall expire November 2, 2021 upon 3 the board's organizational meeting held pursuant to section 4 279.1. 5 EXPLANATION The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 6 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly. 7 This bill relates to the administration of combined city and 8 9 school elections. The bill changes the withdrawal deadline 10 for candidates in a school election from 35 days before the 11 election to 42 days before the election, the same deadline for 12 candidates in a city election. The bill changes the date for 13 a canvass following a municipal election from the Thursday 14 following the election to the Monday or Tuesday following the The bill requires a request for a recount in a 15 election. 16 municipal election to be submitted by the day following the 17 canvass, requires the county board of canvassers to meet by the 18 Friday following the election, and the report on the recount to 19 be filed by the 14th day after the election. 20 The bill requires the board of directors of a merged area 21 to organize at the first regular or special meeting after the 22 canvass of the regular school election. The bill also changes 23 the date of the canvass for an election held in a merged area 24 to the second Monday or Tuesday following an election, the 25 same deadline for a second canvass required of certain cities 26 and school districts pursuant to 2017 Iowa Acts, chapter 155, 27 section 28. 28 The bill changes the expiration date of the terms of office 29 of members of boards of directors of a merged area or school

30 district elected in September 2015 or 2017 to the day of the

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31 board's organizational meeting following the election.
