- 10 Sec. 2. Section 99E.6, subsection 2, Code 2020, is amended
- 11 to read as follows:

- 13 sports contests authorized under this chapter shall be paid by
- 14 the internet fantasy sports contest service provider to the
- 15 treasurer of state as determined by the commission and shall be
- 16 credited as provided in section 8.57, subsection 6 deposited in
