1 Section 1. Section 709.9, Code 2020, is amended to read as
2 follows:

3 709.9 Indecent exposure.

A person who exposes the person's genitals or pubes to 5 another not the person's spouse, or who commits a sex act in 6 the presence of or view of a third person, <u>or who touches</u> 7 <u>the person's genitals outside of or underneath the person's</u> 8 <u>clothing</u>, commits a serious misdemeanor, if <u>all of the</u>

9 following apply:

10 l. The person does so to arouse or satisfy the sexual 11 desires of either party; and party.

12 2. The person knows or reasonably should know that the act 13 is offensive to the viewer or the viewer was a child at the time 14 of the act.

EXPLANATION

16The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with17the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

18 This bill expands the criminal offense of indecent exposure 19 (Code section 709.9) to include a person who touches the 20 person's genitals outside of or underneath the person's 21 clothing, if the person does so to arouse or satisfy the sexual 22 desires of either party and the person knows or reasonably 23 should know that the act is offensive to the viewer or the 24 viewer was a child at the time of the act.

A person who violates Code section 709.9 commits a Serious misdemeanor. A serious misdemeanor is punishable by Confinement for no more than one year and a fine of at least 8 \$315 but not more than \$1,875.

29 A person convicted pursuant to this section is required to 30 register as a sex offender.
