

House Study Bill 560 - Introduced

A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to confidentiality concerning individuals
2 allowed a disabled veteran tax credit.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 425.15, Code 2020, is amended by adding
2 the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 4A. *a.* Except as provided in paragraph
4 "*b*", the name and address of an individual allowed a credit
5 under this section and maintained by the county recorder or
6 other entity is confidential information, unless otherwise
7 ordered by a court or released by the lawful custodian of the
8 records pursuant to state or federal law.

9 *b.* Upon request, a county recorder or other entity may share
10 information as described in paragraph "*a*" to a county veterans
11 service officer for purposes of providing information on
12 benefits and services available to veterans and their families.

13 EXPLANATION

14 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
15 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

16 This bill provides that the name and address of an individual
17 allowed a disabled veteran tax credit and maintained by the
18 county recorder or other entity are confidential. The bill
19 allows a county recorder or other entity to share information
20 otherwise deemed confidential by the bill upon request to a
21 county veterans service officer for purposes of providing
22 information on veterans' benefits.
