A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the amounts a district of residence pays
- 2 to a receiving district for a pupil participating in open
- 3 enrollment and including applicability provisions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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Section 1. Section 282.18, subsection 7, paragraph b, 2 subparagraph (1), Code 2020, is amended to read as follows:

(1) (a) The board of directors of the district of residence
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- 4 shall pay to the receiving district the sum of the state cost 5 per pupil for the previous school year plus either an amount
- 6 equal to the sum of the following:
- 7 <u>(i) Either</u> the teacher leadership supplement state cost per
- 8 pupil for the previous fiscal year as provided in section 257.9 9 or the teacher leadership supplement foundation aid for the
- 10 previous fiscal year as provided in section 284.13, subsection
- 11 1, paragraph "d", if both the district of residence and the
- 12 receiving district are receiving such supplements, plus any.
- 13 (ii) Any moneys received for the pupil as a result of the
- 14 non-English speaking limited English proficient weighting under
- 15 section 280.4, subsection 3, for the previous school year
- 16 multiplied by the state cost per pupil for the previous year.
- 17 (iii) An amount equal to the lesser of the receiving
- 18 district's teacher salary supplement district cost per pupil
- 19 for the previous fiscal year or the district of residence's
- 20 teacher salary supplement district cost per pupil for the
- 21 previous fiscal year, unless the pupil participating in open
- 22 enrollment is receiving educational instruction and course
- 23 content primarily over the internet in accordance with section
- 24 <u>256.7</u>, subsection 32.
- 25 (b) If the pupil participating in open enrollment is also
- 26 an eligible pupil under section 261E.6, the receiving district
- 27 shall pay the tuition reimbursement amount to an eligible
- 28 postsecondary institution as provided in section 261E.7.
- 29 Sec. 2. APPLICABILITY. This Act applies to school budget 30 years beginning on or after July 1, 2020.
- 31 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- Current Code section 282.18(7) provides that a pupil
- 35 participating in open enrollment shall be counted, for state

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- 1 school foundation aid purposes, in the pupil's district of
- 2 residence. The school district of residence is then required
- 3 to pay to the receiving district the sum of the state cost per
- 4 pupil for the previous school year plus either the teacher
- 5 leadership supplement state cost per pupil for the previous
- 6 fiscal year or the teacher leadership supplement foundation aid
- 7 for the previous fiscal year if both the district of residence
- 8 and the receiving district are receiving such supplements,
- 9 plus any moneys received for the pupil as a result of the
- 10 non-English speaking weighting and any eligible postsecondary
- 11 tuition reimbursement amounts under Code section 261E.7, if
- 12 applicable.
- 13 This bill adds to the total amount required to be paid by
- 14 the district of residence to the receiving district an amount
- 15 equal to the lesser of the receiving district's teacher salary
- 16 supplement district cost per pupil for the previous fiscal
- 17 year or the district of residence's teacher salary supplement
- 18 district cost per pupil for the previous fiscal year. However,
- 19 such teacher salary supplement amount is not included in the
- 20 amount paid by the district of residence to the receiving
- 21 district if the pupil participating in open enrollment is
- 22 receiving educational instruction and course content primarily
- 23 over the internet in accordance with Code section 256.7(32).
- The bill applies to school budget years beginning on or after
- 25 July 1, 2020.
