- 1 An Act relating to county commissions of veteran affairs

- 1 Section 1. Section 35A.16, subsection 1, paragraph b, Code 2 2020, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 b. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state
- 4 to the department, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009,
- 5 and for each subsequent fiscal year, the sum of one million
- 6 three hundred thousand dollars to be credited to the county
- 7 commissions of veteran affairs fund.
- 8 Sec. 2. Section 35A.16, subsection 3, paragraph a, Code
- 9 2020, is amended to read as follows:
- 10 a. (1) If sufficient moneys are available, the department
- 11 shall annually allocate ten thousand dollars to each county
- 12 commission of veteran affairs, or to each county sharing the
- 13 services of an executive director or administrator pursuant
- 14 to chapter 28E, to be used to provide services to veterans
- 15 pursuant to section 35B.6.
- 16 (2) If sufficient moneys are available, the department
- 17 shall annually allocate three thousand dollars to each county
- 18 commission of veteran affairs, or to each county sharing the
- 19 services of an executive director or administrator pursuant
- 20 to chapter 28E, to be used for training and related expenses
- 21 of county veteran service officers for purposes of the United
- 22 States department of veterans affairs accreditation program.
- 23 (3) Each county receiving an allocation pursuant to

- 28 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 30 This bill concerns appropriations to and allocations from
- 31 the county commission of veteran affairs fund created in Code
- 32 section 35A.16.
- The bill increases the annual appropriation to the fund from
- 34 the general fund from \$1 million to \$1.3 million each fiscal
- 35 year. The bill also allocates \$3,000 from the fund to each
