## House Study Bill 699 - Introduced

## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to officer disciplinary actions and
- 2 establishing a legislative interim committee.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. BRADY-GIGLIO LIST INTERIM COMMITTEE.

2 1. The legislative council is requested to establish a
 3 Brady-Giglio list interim committee for the 2020 interim. The
 4 purpose of the committee shall be to do all of the following:

a. Study the disclosure of information contained in officer
6 personnel files as such information relates to a Brady-Giglio
7 list.

8 b. Study the efficiency of implementing a statewide system 9 for a Brady-Giglio list, identifying impartial entities to 10 conduct investigations pertaining to an officer's acts or 11 omissions to act, and recommending the appropriate procedures, 12 due process protections, appeal rights, and criteria for the 13 placement and removal of an officer's name on and from a 14 Brady-Giglio list.

15 c. Study any other issues that the committee determines 16 relevant to its objective. The committee may solicit the 17 advice or testimony of any organization or individual with 18 information or expertise relevant to the purpose of the 19 committee.

20 2. The committee shall consist of three members of the 21 senate appointed by the majority leader of the senate, two 22 members of the senate appointed by the minority leader of the 23 senate, three members of the house of representatives appointed 24 by the speaker of the house of representatives, and two members 25 of the house of representatives appointed by the minority 26 leader of the house of representatives. Additional committee 27 members shall include the commissioner of the department of 28 public safety or the commissioner's designee, a district court 29 judge appointed by the supreme court, and representatives from 30 all of the following: the Iowa county attorneys association, 31 the Iowa sheriffs and deputies association, the Iowa police 32 chiefs association, the Iowa state police association, the 33 Iowa peace officers association, the Iowa professional fire 34 fighters, the Iowa state troopers association, and the Iowa 35 state patrol supervisors association. 2 who does not hold rank.

3 3. The committee shall elect a chairperson from the members4 appointed.

5 4. The committee shall issue a report, including findings 6 and recommendations, to the governor and the general assembly 7 no later than December 16, 2020.

8 5. For the purposes of this section, "Brady-Giglio list" 9 means a list of officers maintained by the county attorney's 10 office, including officers who may not have disclosed all 11 impeachment information and officers who may have violated the 12 pretrial discovery rule requiring officers to turn over all 13 evidence that might be used to exonerate a defendant. 14 EXPLANATION

15The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with16the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

17 This bill establishes a legislative interim committee 18 relating to officer disciplinary actions.

19 The bill establishes a legislative interim committee 20 to study the disclosure of officer personnel files as 21 such information relates to a Brady-Giglio list, study 22 the efficiency of implementing a statewide system for a 23 Brady-Giglio list, identify impartial entities to conduct 24 investigations pertaining to an officer's acts and omissions 25 to act, and recommend appropriate procedures, due process 26 protections, appeal rights, and criteria for the placement 27 and removal of an officer's name on and from a Brady-Giglio 28 list. The committee may solicit the advice or testimony of 29 any organization or individual with information or expertise 30 relevant to its study.

The committee shall consist of 10 legislative members and 10 members representing various interested stakeholder organizations, the department of public safety, and the court. The committee shall issue a report, including findings and recommendations, to the governor and the general assembly no

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1 later than December 16, 2020.

2 The bill defines "Brady-Giglio list" as a list of officers 3 maintained by the county attorney's office, including officers 4 who may not have disclosed all impeachment information and 5 pursuant to Giglio v. U.S., 405 U.S. 150 (1972), and officers 6 who may have violated the pretrial discovery rule established 7 by Brady v. Maryland, 373 U.S. 83 (1963), requiring officers 8 to turn over all evidence that may be used to exonerate a 9 defendant.

Under Code section 80F.1, "officer" means a certified law enforcement officer, fire fighter, emergency medical technician, corrections officer, detention officer, jailer, probation or parole officer, communications officer, or any other law enforcement officer certified by the Iowa law enforcement academy and employed by a municipality, county, or state agency.

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
