## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act concerning the display of the POW/MIA flag on public
- 2 buildings.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1B.3, Code 2020, is amended to read as 2 follows:
- 3 1B.3 Flags on public buildings.
- 4 It shall be the duty of any board of public officers charged
- 5 with providing supplies for a public building in the state
- 6 to provide a suitable state flag and it shall be the duty of
- 7 the custodian of that public building to raise the flags of
- 8 the United States of America, and the state of Iowa, and the
- 9 national league of POW/MIA families' flag, upon each secular
- 10 day when weather conditions are favorable. The national league
- 11 of POW/MIA families' flag shall be flown underneath the flag of
- 12 the United States of America and the flag of the state of Iowa.
- 13 EXPLANATION
- 14 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 15 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 16 This bill provides that the custodian of a public building
- 17 shall raise the national league of POW/MIA families' flag upon
- 18 each secular day when weather conditions are favorable. The
- 19 bill provides that the national league of POW/MIA families'
- 20 flag shall be flown underneath the flag of the United States of
- 21 America and the flag of the state of Iowa.
