(SUCCESSOR TO SSB 1017)

**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to going armed with, carrying, or transporting  
2 a firearm when transporting a person to or from a school or  
3 delivering an item to the school.  
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 724.4B, subsection 2, Code 2019, is  
2 amended by adding the following new paragraph:

3 NEW PARAGRAPH. *Ob.* A person listed under section 724.4,  
4 subsection 4, paragraph "i", if the person is on the grounds of  
5 the school for the purpose of transporting another person to or  
6 from school or delivering an item to or from the school, and if  
7 the person remains in a parking area or driveway designed for a  
8 motor vehicle.

EXPLANATION

10 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with  
11 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

12 This bill relates to going armed with, carrying, or  
13 transporting a firearm when transporting a person to or from a  
14 school or delivering an item to or from the school.

15 The bill provides that a person with a valid nonprofessional  
16 permit to carry weapons may go armed with, carry, or transport  
17 a firearm on school grounds when the person is on the grounds  
18 of the school for the purpose of transporting another person to  
19 or from school or delivering an item to or from the school, and  
20 if the person remains in a parking area or driveway designed  
21 for a motor vehicle.

22 A person who goes armed with, carries, or transports a  
23 firearm on the grounds of a school in violation of Code section  
24 724.4B commits a class "D" felony. A class "D" felony is  
25 punishable by confinement for no more than five years and a  
26 fine of at least \$750 but not more than \$7,500.
