A BILL FOR

1 An Act requiring political subdivisions of the state to prepare
2 salary reports.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 70A.21 Political subdivisions —
2 salary reports.

3 Each political subdivision of this state shall, by
4 November 1 of each year, prepare and make available to the
5 public a salary report on certain personnel of the political
6 subdivision. The report shall contain the name, gender, county
7 or city of residence when possible, official title, salary
8 received during the previous fiscal year, base salary as
9 computed on July 1 of the current fiscal year, and traveling
10 and subsistence expenses of personnel who receive an annual
11 salary of not less than an amount equal to the statewide
12 average weekly wage, as defined in section 96.19, for the
13 applicable fiscal year multiplied by fifty-two.

14 EXPLANATION

15 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
16 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

17 This bill requires each political subdivision of the state
18 to prepare and make available to the public by November 1
19 of each year a salary report on certain personnel of that
20 political subdivision. The bill requires the report to contain
21 the name, gender, county or city of residence when possible,
22 official title, salary received during the previous fiscal
23 year, base salary, and traveling and subsistence expenses of
24 personnel of the applicable political subdivision who receive
25 an annual salary of not less than an amount equal to the
26 statewide average weekly wage, as defined in Code section
27 96.19, multiplied by 52.
