A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the residency of members of the armed forces
2 stationed at specified military installations for purposes
3 of hunting, fishing, and trapping privileges.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 483A.1A, subsection 10, paragraph e,
2 Code 2019, is amended by striking the paragraph and inserting
3 in lieu thereof the following:

4 e. Is a member of the armed forces of the United States
5 who is serving on active duty and meets any of the following
6 qualifications:

7 (1) Claims residency in this state and has filed a state
8 individual income tax return as a resident pursuant to chapter
9 422, division II, for the preceding tax year.

10 (2) Is stationed at a federal military installation in this
11 state, or at a federal military installation contiguous to a
12 county in this state, and is domiciled within this state.

13 (3) Is stationed at and resides or is domiciled within a
14 federal military installation located contiguous to a county
15 in this state.

16 (4) Is the spouse of a person included in subparagraph (1),
17 (2), or (3).

18 EXPLANATION

19 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
20 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

21 This bill changes the definition of "resident" in Code
22 chapter 483A to include a member of the armed forces of
23 the United States who is stationed at a federal military
24 installation in this state, or contiguous to a county in this
25 state, and is domiciled within the state. The bill amends the
26 definition of resident to also include a member of the armed
27 forces who is stationed at and resides or is domiciled within a
28 federal military installation located contiguous to a county
29 in this state. The definition also includes the spouse of
30 a person who is a resident pursuant to Code section 483A.1A,
31 subsection 10, paragraph "e". A resident for purposes of Code
32 chapter 483A is entitled to certain privileges related to
33 hunting, fishing, and trapping.
