A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to immunization information requested on an
2 infant certificate of death form.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. INFANT CERTIFICATE OF DEATH FORM — INFORMATION
2 REGARDING IMMUNIZATIONS.

3 1. The certificate of death form for medical examiner
4 cases for infants zero to three years of age shall include
5 a request for information regarding the date and type of the
6 decedent's last immunization. If the decedent received more
7 than one immunization at the time of the last immunization, the
8 information provided shall include all types of immunizations
9 received.

10 2. The department of public health shall adopt rules
11 pursuant to chapter 17A to amend the certificate of death form
12 for medical examiner cases for infants zero to three years of
13 age to comply with this section.

14 EXPLANATION

15 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
16 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

17 This bill requires that a certificate of death form for
18 medical examiner cases for infants zero to three years of age
19 shall include a request for information regarding the date and
20 type of the decedent's last immunization. If the decedent
21 received more than one immunization at the time of the last
22 immunization, the information provided shall include all types
23 of immunizations received. The bill requires the department
24 of public health to adopt administrative rules to amend the
25 certificate of death form for medical examiner cases for
26 infants zero to three years of age to comply with the bill.
