A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the definition of young adult for purposes
2 of participation in the preparation for adult living
3 program.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 234.46, subsection 1, paragraph c, Code
2 2020, is amended to read as follows:

3 c. At the time the person became age eighteen, the person
4 received foster care services that were paid for by the state
5 under [section 234.35](#), services at a state training school,
6 services at a juvenile shelter care home, ~~or~~ services at a
7 juvenile detention home, or court-ordered care by a relative or
8 another person with a significant relationship with the person,
9 and the person is no longer receiving such services or care.

EXPLANATION

This bill relates to the definition of "young adult" for
14 purposes of participation in the preparation for adult living
15 program (program).

16

The purpose of the program is to assist young adult persons
17 who are leaving foster care and other court-ordered services at
18 age 18 or older in making the transition to self-sufficiency.

The bill includes a person who, at the time the person turned
20 18 years of age, received court-ordered care with a relative or
21 another person with a significant relationship with the person,
22 in the eligibility criteria for young adult participation in
23 the program.
